## Principal's Desk

The Annual Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm and energy, showcasing a perfect harmony of athletic excellence and a vibrant fusion of culture and sports. The Theme — **'A River of Vitality: Harmony in Motion, Balancing Mind, Body, and Spirit'** resonated in the spirit of the students who participated in different events, including athletics, yoga, taekwondo and skipping. The mesmerizing performances by the orchestra, choir, and dancers enthralled the audience. A sense of pride filled the parents and teachers as they saw the students scaling great heights and the excitement that intensified during the athletic events was a sight to behold.

Fostering inclusivity remains at the core of our values and tradition. We aspire to sensitize our students in school to show support and solidarity to children with special needs. Witnessing students participate enthusiastically in various races and events was overwhelming. The sense of triumph was evident when they came to collect the certificates and medals. What the parents saw on the final day was a six month-long effort to train children for different events so that they are not only aware of the rules but learn discipline and hone the skills needed to excel. It is rightly said, "Excellence is not a singular act but what you do repeatedly." Through regular sports, our students stay fit, learn to follow rules as well as build relationships with their peers through mutual trust and respect. We encourage and equip our students to take up sports not to necessarily become a sports person but embrace it as a way of life because of the great lessons it teaches us about life, health, and collaboration.

The classes have resumed in full swing and the focus is academics. The high levels of pollution could not upset the functioning of the school and the transition to online classes was seamless. A plethora of online resources are being explored and used by our teachers to make online classes a fulfilling experience for the students.

Our major concern these days is poor attendance in the offline and online classes especially in the senior school. The syllabus is towards completion which will be followed by revision and practice for boards and final exams. It is mandatory for all students to come to school and have at least 75 percent attendance according to CBSE norms. Medical issues must be reported immediately to the class teachers and must be supported by a medical certificate attested by a certified doctor. It must be noted that not attending school results in a gap in their learning and thus, parents must instil in their wards a sense of responsibility towards this. Apart from academics, school prepares us for life ahead and thus, it is our collective responsibility to ensure that our children are present mentally and physically.

The events that have occurred in the last few months urges me to reiterate our collective responsibility. Unless we take a collaborative stance we will not be able to keep our children safe and ensure that they grow up in an environment that supports their well-being. The line between caring for and fulfilling every desire of our children, is often blurred, sending wrong messages to them and allowing for unfortunate incidents. Setting and upholding safety standards and developing in our children a sense of responsibility is of utmost importance. It will go a long way in sending out into the world, a set of young adults who have fewer grey areas. Following rules whether set by parents, guardians, society or the schools, is important and there must be no dichotomy there. On behalf of our children I encourage you to take those tough decisions, to take a stand and not allow our children to convince us that rules and processes don't matter when it is inconvenient to follow. Let us be the adults that our children need us to be.

I pray that the Almighty keeps all our students healthy and safe.
