

REPORT ON ECO CREATIVITY AND INNOVATION HACKATHON ORGANIZED BY PI JAM FOUNDATION

JMIS participated in the Eco-Creativity & Innovation Hackathon, an initiative by MoEFCC in collaboration with Pi Jam Foundation, launched on World Environment Day, 5th June 2024, aiming to empower students to become eco-problem solvers through technology and creativity. The hackathon event was held at NDMC Convention Centre, New Delhi on 17th December 2024.

Out of approximately 690,000 participants nationwide, Grade IX student Ansh Tomar's innovative idea for environmental conservation was selected among the top 35 submissions. He got a chance to present his prototype before MoEFCC officials during the national showcase.

In recognition of his contribution, Ansh received a participation certificate and a tinkering kit as rewards for his innovative idea.
