

Aryabhat Ganit Challenge 2024



In a magnificent feat, Romir Pramanik of The Air Force School, Subroto Park is among the top 100 students in the Aryabhat Ganit Challenge organised by CBSE. Romir successfully cleared both Stage 1 and Stage 2 of the national-level competition, securing a coveted position among the Top 100 students from the Delhi East region under CBSE.

CBSE conducts the Aryabhat Ganit Challenge (AGC) to foster the development of essential competencies in applying mathematics to everyday situations. The challenge is designed to:

- Develop students' ability to apply mathematical concepts in real-life scenarios
- Encourage a more holistic understanding of mathematics
- Enhance students' mathematical knowledge and transferable skills.

The AGC 2024 was conducted at two levels.

Level 1: School Level Competition was conducted by the School on 30 August 2024. A Question Paper for Level 1 competition was provided by CBSE through its portal. Schools downloaded the Question Paper and conducted the examination. All interested students of class VIII-X participated in it.

Level 2: National Level Competition was conducted by CBSE as a Computer based test on 08 October 2024. Top three students from each affiliated school registered for the first stage participated in it.

The top 100 students from each CBSE region who successfully complete the second stage are given a merit certificate.
