Monday 20.01.25	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Math</u></p> <p>Multiplication</p> <p>Introduction</p> <p>Multiplication is the repeated addition of a number.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) $3 \times 2 = 3 + 3 = 6$b) $5 \times 3 = 5 + 5 + 5 = 15$c) $6 \times 4 = 6 + 6 + 6 + 6 = 24$d) $7 \times 3 = 7 + 7 + 7 = 21$e) $2 \times 6 = 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 + 2 = 12$ <p>The answer of multiplication is called product.</p> <p>FACTS \longrightarrow</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">1) If we multiply any no. by 0 the product is always 0. For e.g. $6 \times 0 = 0$ $2 \times 0 = 0$2) When we multiply a number by 1, the product is the number itself. For e.g.- $4 \times 1 = 4$ $9 \times 1 = 9$3) If we change the order of the number, the product remains the same.
