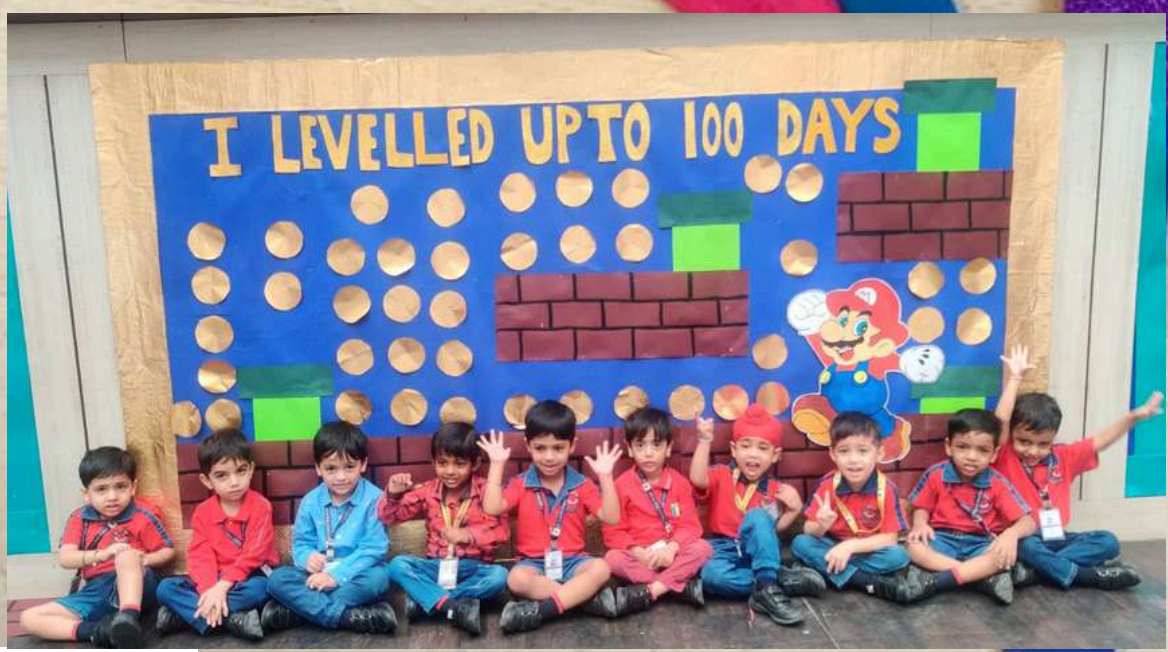

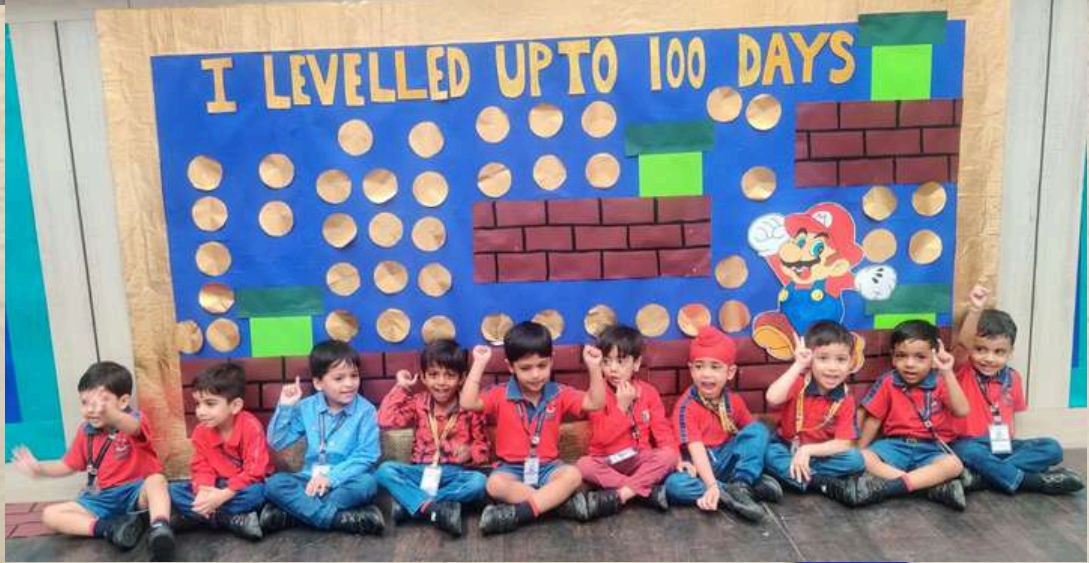
"As we celebrate 100 days of school, we are reminded of the incredible journey of our students every year. The laughter, tears and triumphs - it's all part of the learning process.

With twinkling eyes and sparkling smiles, sang, danced and acted out the story of Jesus' birth.





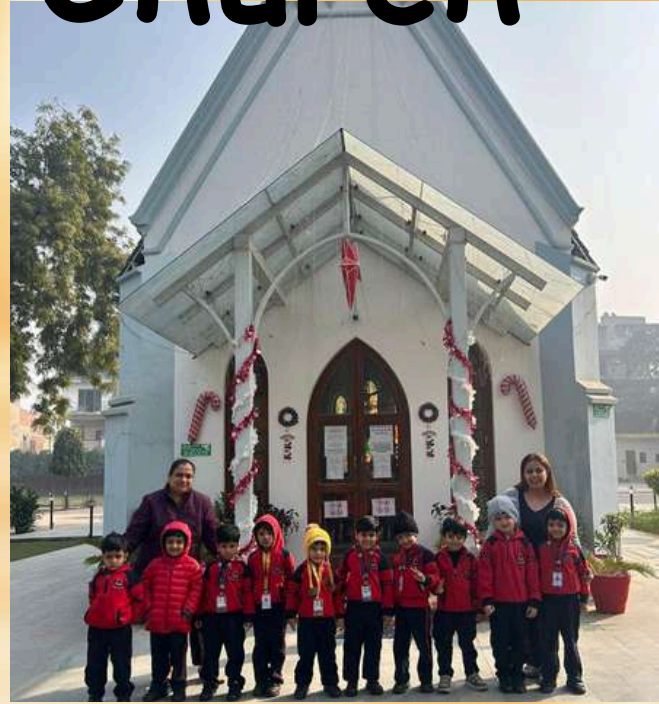
Visit to Church


