SPECIAL ASSEMBLY DIWALI (VI G)



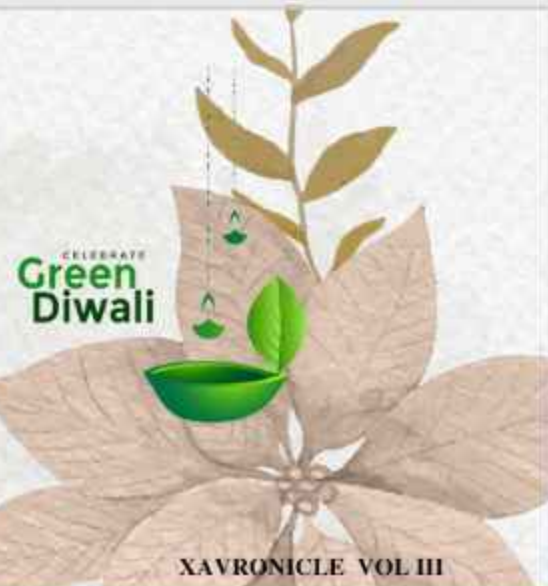

VISIT TO RECYCLING UNIT CENTRE



My Trip to the Recycling Unit

The recycling unit we visited was called the Badshahpur Forest Corridor, a place that immediately captivated us with its lush greenery and vibrant plant life. Everywhere we looked, there was an array of plants, creating a refreshing environment.

Our first stop was a small but efficient waste segregation unit. Here, we observed the separation of paper, plastic, and metal waste. An informative banner caught our attention, displaying the percentages of different types of waste produced: approximately 60% dry waste, 35% wet waste, and around 2%-5% hazardous waste.

Next, we were taken to a beautifully designed amphitheater surrounded by greenery. The presenter, who was highly knowledgeable, explained the recycling unit's origins. It was created in partnership with a company called 'I AM GURGAON', founded by three visionary women who wanted to transform Gurugram from a landfill into a thriving green space. Interestingly, the land where the unit stands today was once a landfill. Through their efforts, they cleared the area and turned it into the lush green haven we were exploring.

The presenter went on to explain the three types of waste: hazardous, biodegradable, and non-biodegradable. She clarified that biodegradable waste includes items that can decompose naturally, non-biodegradable waste consists of items that cannot be recycled, and hazardous waste includes anything harmful to humans and nature. She emphasised how proper segregation is crucial to achieving the goal of zero waste.

After this, we had a discussion about how waste is segregated in our school and the practices we could implement to improve it. I suggested that old and used notebooks at the end of the school year could be sent to recycling units to be converted into paper. The presenter really liked my suggestion and shared an inspiring insight—this is already being done in some places, where recycled notebooks are turned into mats for underprivileged children to sit on while studying.

Following this discussion, we embarked on a nature walk. Along the way, we marvelled at numerous types of plants and even played in a small playground. One fascinating detail was that the very path we were walking on was made from recycled rocks salvaged from demolished roads and buildings.

As the visit came to an end, they gifted us small, reusable cloth bags, encouraging us to adopt sustainable habits. This exciting and informative experience left a lasting impression on me. I know I will never forget this trip and the valuable lessons it taught me about sustainability and waste management.

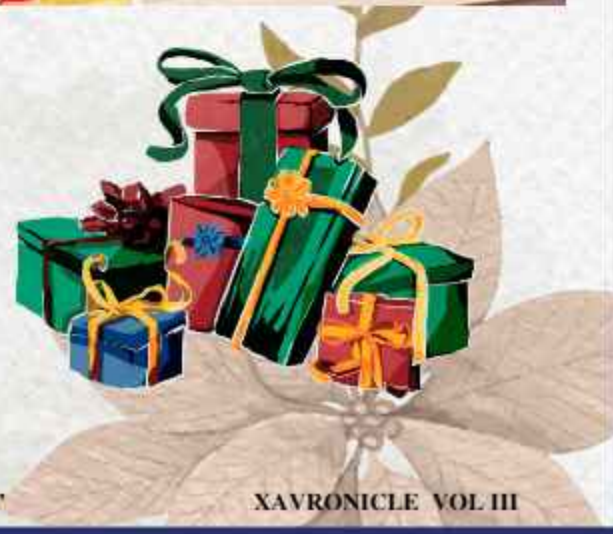
