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


TRINITY ONLINE SESSION

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


NIGHT CAMP

INTRA - CLASS MIME COMPETITION





INTER-HOUSE CRICKET MATCH BOYS



GRADE 3 STUDENTS AT ST. XAVIER'S SCHOOL EXPLORED THE CONCEPT OF DIVISION THROUGH A CREATIVE AND HANDS-ON SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITY. USING 4 PAPER-CUT CLOUDS AND 12 PAPER-CUT STARS, THE YOUNG LEARNERS WERE INTRODUCED TO THE IDEA OF EQUAL DISTRIBUTION.

THE TASK WAS TO DIVIDE THE 12 STARS EQUALLY AMONG THE 4 CLOUDS. AS THE STUDENTS CAREFULLY PLACED THE STARS ONTO THE CLOUDS, THEY OBSERVED THAT EACH CLOUD RECEIVED EXACTLY 3 STARS, ARRIVING AT THE CONCLUSION THAT 12 DIVIDED BY 4 EQUALS 3.

THIS INTERACTIVE ACTIVITY BROUGHT THE ABSTRACT CONCEPT OF DIVISION TO LIFE, ALLOWING STUDENTS TO VISUALIZE AND UNDERSTAND IT IN A SIMPLE, ENGAGING WAY. IT ALSO ENCOURAGED ACTIVE PARTICIPATION, TEAMWORK, AND LOGICAL REASONING.

THE JOYFUL FACES OF THE STUDENTS AND THEIR ENTHUSIASM THROUGHOUT THE ACTIVITY REFLECTED ITS SUCCESS. ST. XAVIER'S SCHOOL CONTINUES TO FOSTER INNOVATIVE TEACHING METHODS TO MAKE LEARNING ENJOYABLE AND EFFECTIVE FOR ITS STUDENTS.
