## Snippets from the School's Beginnings

I would like to share some of my cherished recollections and challenges we faced in the early years of the school and I hope you will get inspired by this journey from modest beginnings. From my childhood, I saw that my mother had a singular purpose: to open her own school. She had worked as a school administrator in Rajasthan and later in a school in West Delhi for a number of years. She zeroed in on the Palam area and then rented a place in Sadh Nagar to start the school. She was driven by a sense of purpose: to establish an institution where education would be rooted in good values and that made her give up her secure job and embark on this journey of uncertainty.

The challenges in the initial days were immense. The first classrooms were makeshift rooms: the walls were made of mud. The classrooms used to flood with knee high water during some heavy monsoons and we would work tirelessly to save books & registers and to ensure the safety of the children. Despite these adversities, there was an unwavering spirit of perseverance and determination to carry on. Today it seems incredible how we were able to establish the school after facing so many challenges.

When my father retired, he became a pillar of support, overseeing the construction of the school buildings. He wanted the school to have excellent

infrastructure and the best facilities so the students could have a conducive learning environment. Together, my parents exemplified tireless effort and commitment to education. From them, I imbibed these values, which continue to guide me in ensuring that Shiv Vani remains a stellar establishment. Today, it is a matter of pride that our school stands as one of the finest in West Delhi, renowned for its infrastructure, academic achievements and co-curricular excellence and the accomplishments of our alumni.

## New Initiatives

This academic year has been remarkable as we introduced several new initiatives aimed at fostering critical thinking, creativity & leadership skills among our students. From creative initiatives to Science Exhibitions and competitions at Zonal and at Inter -school levels, our students have demonstrated their ability to lead and excel.
