


TRANSFORMATION TO ONLINE LEARNING-A NEW NORMAL

We are passing through the nightmare of Corona Virus, an invisible demon, has virtually engulfed human civilization in totality and threatened to stop wheels of human life to grinding halt. This is a crisis world never expected to encounter even in its remotest dream and the most people in this generation never experienced earlier.

Since the last few months, there has been a drastic shift in the way we have been conducting ourselves for many years now. The transitioning alterations in the way we live, observe, interact, and perform our duty has been reconstructed. The Corona virus pandemic has aggrieved our families, communities, the economy, organizational institutions, schools, and our perceived way of life. We share your anxiety and unanimously stand in solidarity with you and your family during these formidable times.

The first wave of COVID-19 cases started being registered in India around the first week of March and as a school, we were perceptive to realize the precariousness of the situation that was on the horizon.





We discerned that there is a possibility that schools may not open for an unprecedented time this academic year. Hence, normal classroom activities may be disrupted and continuing our engagement remotely might be our only possibility. We preemptively started working towards developing a strategy for continuing our children's productive learning process.

On 26th March2020, two days after the national lockdown was announced, we were among the first schools in the country to have our online classrooms up and running. By April 2020, before the new session of 2020-21 was scheduled to reopen, classes from 6 to 9 were efficiently functioning online. Gradually Nursery to Class-5 also transformed to online mode.

Switching to online schooling comes with a steep learning curve, each 40 minutes session with students involves hours of pre-planning.

Starting May 25th, online classes began for yoga and physical exercise. These activities received an enthusiastic acceptance by the students with everyone involved actively at home.

Acquiring special government permissions to deliver all books and consumables to your doorsteps with strict precaution and safety concord set in place. This particular task involved exposure to a high-risk environment for the members of our team.

Online learning is an evolving process, we have come a long way in this journey, and yet, we have a long way to go. Gradually we have been into this "new normal". Hence, it requires adaptation from all of us to meet the needs of everyone involved.


IIT KANPUR - NATIONAL ANVESHIKA EXPERIMENTAL SKILL TEST




Experiments are an integral part of science and innovation. With careful observations and suitably designed experiments, the course of human development has changed in all aspects.



A Poem


When I begin writing a poem,
