Class	Activity	Description
VIII	Bookmark Making- 'Words of Wisdom' (Inter Class)	Students will design bookmarks featuring Dr. Ambedkar's most inspirational quotes. The designs should incorporate artistic elements that reflect his teachings on equality, justice, and education.
IX	Poster-Making Competition (Inter Class)	Theme: Ambedkar's India – A Vision for Equality Students are invited to create posters that depict Dr. Ambedkar's vision of an egalitarian India, highlighting his contributions to social justice.
X	Preamble Art Challenge (Inter House)	Each house will create a decorative or calligraphy-based version of the Preamble of the Indian Constitution.
XI	Reimagine the Rupee – Currency Design Contest (Inter House)	Students will design a special edition of the 100 rupees note, featuring Dr. Ambedkar with symbols representing his contributions.
