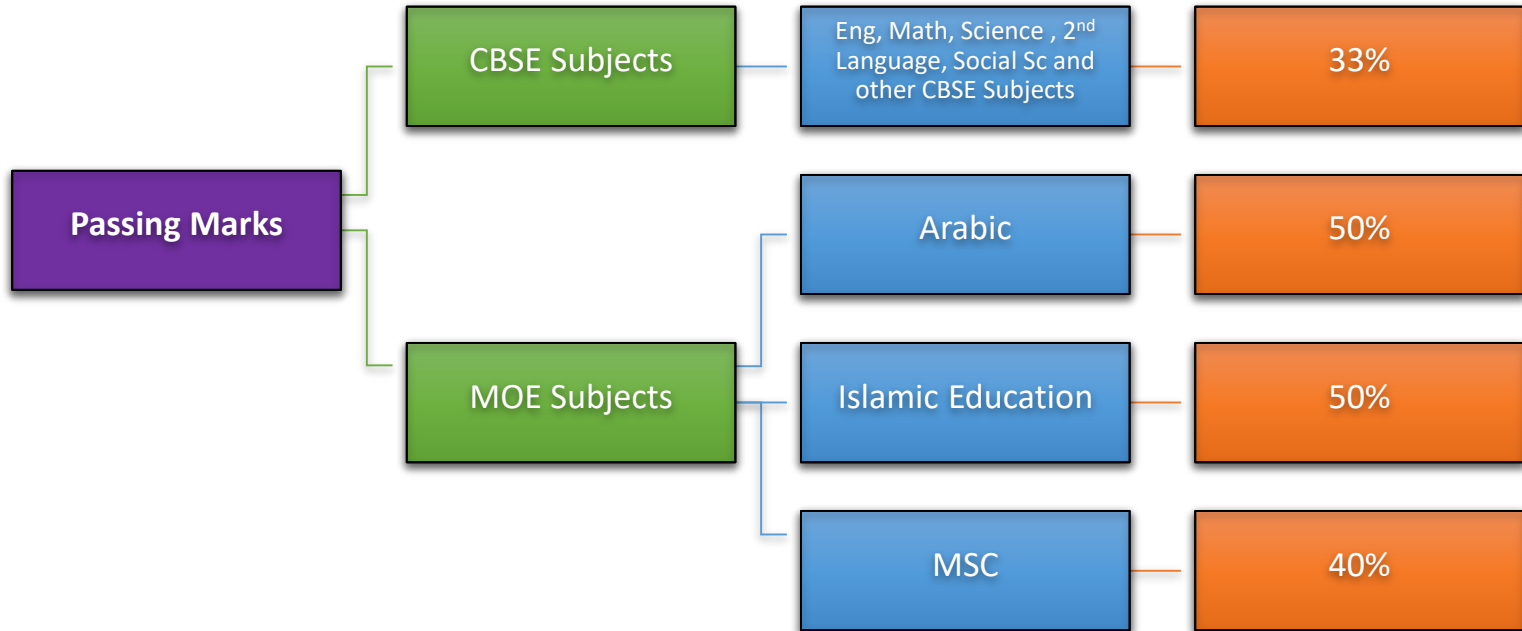




# Promotion Policy



- **Note : In order to be promoted to the next class, a student must secure 33% in each CBSE subject in the final examination as well as in cumulative score.**



# PROMOTION POLICY : GRADE 4 TO 9 : 2025-2026

## Promotion:

- In order to be promoted to next class, a student must secure :
- **33% in each CBSE subject in the annual examination as well as in cumulative score.**
- **50% in Arabic & Islamic Education and 40% in MSC in cumulative score.**
- **75% attendance in the academic year.**

## Compartment(Retest) :

- Students will appear for retest if :
  - He/she fails to secure **33% in two or less CBSE subjects either in the annual examination or in the cumulative scores**
  - He/she fails to secure **50% in Arabic or Islamic Education or 40% in MSC in cumulative score**
- ⑩ The syllabus of the compartment examination in a subject will be the same as that in Annual Examination.
- ⑩ There will not be a second Compartment Exam under any circumstances and reasons (medical or otherwise).
- ⑩ **The student must secure minimum passing marks(33% in each CBSE subject and 50% in Arabic & Islamic Education and 40% in MSC) in the compartment exam to be promoted to next class.**

## Detained:

- If a student secures **less than 33% in more than two CBSE subjects** in the Annual examination or in cumulative scores, the student will be **detained (repeat the same class)**.

## Unfair Means:

- Students found using any unfair means during any of the examinations, **will be awarded zero in that subject.**

## PROMOTION RULES : GRADE 10

### Promotion:

- In order to be declared pass, a student must secure:
  - **33% in each CBSE subject** in the **board examination** as well as in the **Internal Exams**.
  - **50% in Islamic Studies( for Muslim Students Only) in cumulative score**.
  - 75% attendance in the academic year.

### Compartment(Retest)

- Students will appear for compartment exam :
  - He/she fails to secure **33% in two or less CBSE subject in the board examination**
  - He/she fails to secure **50% in Islamic Education in cumulative score**

### Detained:

- If a student secures **less than 33% in more than two CBSE subject** in the board examination or in internal exams/ Project/ Practical, the student will be **detained (repeat the same class)**.

# PROMOTION POLICY : GRADE 11 : 2025-2026

## Promotion:

- In order to be promoted to next class, a student must secure :
- **33% in each CBSE subject in the annual examination(theory and practical separately) as well as in cumulative score.**
- **50% in Islamic Education in cumulative score.**
- **75% attendance in the academic year.**

## Compartment(Retest)

- Students will appear for retest if :
  - He/she fails to secure **33% in one CBSE subject either in the annual examination or in the cumulative scores**
  - He/she fails to secure **50% in Islamic Education in cumulative score**
- The syllabus of the compartment examination in a subject will be the same as that in Annual Examination.
- There will not be a second Compartment Exam under any circumstances and reasons (medical or otherwise).
- **The student must secure minimum passing marks(33% in each CBSE subject and 50% in Islamic Education in the compartment exam to be promoted to next class.**

## Detained:

- If a student secures **less than 33% in more than one CBSE subject** in the Annual examination or in cumulative scores, the student will be **detained (repeat the same class).**

## Unfair Means:

- Students found using any unfair means during any of the examinations, **will be awarded zero in that subject.**

## PROMOTION RULES : GRADE 12

### Promotion:

- In order to be declared pass, a student must secure:
  - **33% in each CBSE subject** in the **board examination** as well as in the **Internal Exams/ Board Practical/Projects.**
  - **50% in Islamic Education( for Muslim Students Only) in cumulative score.**
  - 75% attendance in the academic year.

### Compartment

- Students will appear for compartment exam :
  - He/she fails to secure **33% in one CBSE subject in the board examination**
  - He/she fails to secure **50% in Islamic Education in cumulative score**

### Detained:

- If a student secures **less than 33% in more than one CBSE subject** in the board examination or in internal exams/ Project/ Practical, the student will be **detained (repeat the same class).**



## **MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS**

Appearing in Periodic Reviews, Half Yearly Examination, and Final Examination is mandatory.

No examination will be conducted either before or after the scheduled date and time.

If a student has not appeared in an examination, she/he will be marked absent and will be awarded a ZERO.



## **ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT**

Minimum 75% attendance during the academic year.

In case a student falls short of the mandatory attendance, then he/she will not be eligible to be promoted to next class.
