


Noun Tree – Students will draw a tree and paste nouns as leaves.

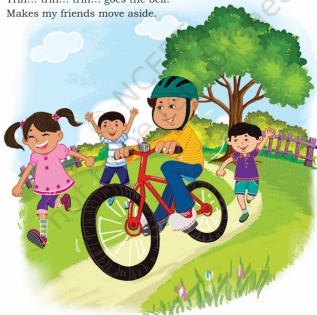


• Poem – “My Bicycle”
