Nouns-Singular and Plural

We already know about **naming words**. Naming words are also called nouns.

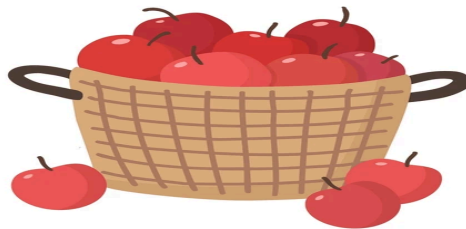
Singular Noun

A noun that denotes only one person, place, animal or thing is called a singular **noun**.



There is only one apple and one basket, so they are **singular nouns**.

Plural Noun



A noun that denotes more than one person, place, animal or thing is a plural **noun**.
