Theme: Friendship, Grammar Fun & Creative Learning

To be done on: A4 size ruled and plain sheets

Cover Page: Design a creative cover page titled: "Milo, Mili & Lisa – My English Holiday Fun!"

- Draw Lisa and her teddy Mili in a garden or room
- Add hearts, stars, and friendship quotes
- Include your Name, Class, Section, and Roll No.

Activities:

1. My Best Friend (English + Moral Science + Art)

On a ruled sheet:

• Write 5–6 lines about your best friend using capital letters correctly for names and places.

On a plain sheet:

- Draw or paste a photo of you with your friend (or draw both of you).
- Decorate the sheet with a friendship border (flowers, stars, etc.)
- 2. Teddy Bear Craft (English + Art + Cutting-Pasting)

Create a teddy bear cut - out using old paper / fabric / craft material.

- Stick it on a plain sheet.
- Write the teddy's name and a line: "My teddy is my soft and sweet friend."
- Remember to use capital letters for the name.
- 3. Grammar Hunt (English Grammar + Cutting-Pasting + EVS)

From old newspapers or magazines cut and paste 6 words that are:

• Names of people, cities, countries, rivers, mountains, days of the week, or months. Paste them neatly in a table on a ruled sheet with proper headings

OR

- Paste pictures of Monuments, Mountains, Schools, Places, People, etc which start with the capital letter and write their names under the picture highlighting the capital letter
- 4. Mini Poem: "A Friend Like You" (English + Creative Writing)

- Write a short 4-line poem on friendship using rhyming words.
- Decorate with small drawings or stickers of hearts, stars, and teddy bears.





1. Make any **two models** based on the following options:

a. Solar System Model

Materials: Thermocol sheet, foam balls (for planets), paint, sticks, glue.

<u>Activity</u>: Paint and arrange the planets in order around the sun on a thermocol base. Label each planet.

b. Water Cycle Model

Materials: Cardboard, cotton, blue cellophane paper, markers.

<u>Activity</u>: Show evaporation, condensation, precipitation, and collection using labels and drawings.

c. Plant Life Cycle

Materials: Chart paper, seeds, cotton, glue, drawings or cutouts.

<u>Activity</u>: Show the stages: seed \rightarrow sprout \rightarrow plant \rightarrow flower \rightarrow fruit. You can even grow a seed in a cup.

d. Parts of a Plant (3D Model)

Materials: Paper, pipe cleaners, clay, labels.

<u>Activity</u>: Make roots, stem, leaves, flower using craft materials and label each part.

Please assemble these models using common household materials and ensure you are prepared to showcase them in class after the summer break.
