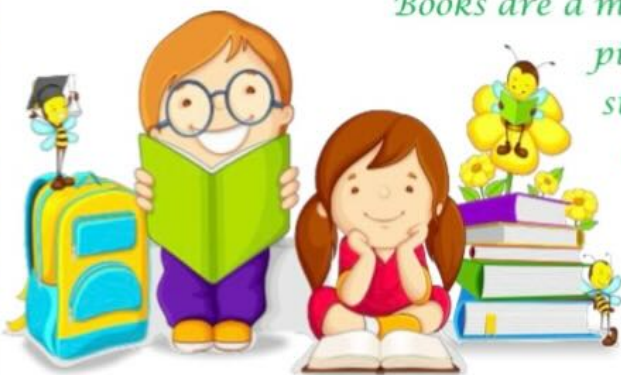
DEAR PARENTS
