SEWA PROJECT

"Reduce, Recycle, Reuse (the most important 3Rs) – and Now Respect"

Project Overview:

This SEWA project encourages students to practice sustainability through the three vital Rs—Reduce, Recycle, Reuse, and now, Respect—for nature and resources. Divided into three groups, students will creatively engage in hands-on tasks that reflect environmental awareness and responsibility.

Project Guidelines for All Groups:

- Students must work on their assigned activity as per their roll number grouping.
- Projects must be neat, presentable, and include a short explanation (written or oral) of the concept behind their creation.
- All materials used must be eco-friendly or waste items—no new materials should be purchased.
- Students are encouraged to show creativity, teamwork (if working in pairs), and a thoughtful message about sustainability.

Group I (Roll No. 1–15): DIY Eco-Friendly Tote Bags

Project Requirement:

- Old/worn-out T-shirts
- Scissors
- Markers or fabric paint (optional for decoration)

Project Content:

- Convert an old T-shirt into a no-sew tote bag.
- Add designs or eco-messages like "Say No to Plastic" or "I Care for Earth".
- Attach a small label or tag explaining the reuse idea and the 3Rs.

Submission Report Must Include:

- Student name & roll number
- Before and after photos of the T-shirt
- 4–5 lines about why reuse is important

Group II (Roll No. 16-30): Collage on 3Rs Using Newspaper & Water

Project Requirement:

- Old newspapers
- Water & glue (for paper pulp or collage base)
- Chart paper or cardboard backing
- Optional: eco-slogans, sketches

Project Content:

- Create a visually appealing collage showcasing the importance of Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle.
- Use only newspaper to design images, symbols, or keywords around the 3Rs.
- Include one message of "Respect" for the environment.

Submission Report Must Include:

- Student name & roll number
- Title of the collage
- 5–6 sentences explaining what each "R" means and how it can be practiced

Group III (Roll No. 31 onwards): Useful/Decorative Items from Waste

Project Requirement:

- Waste materials (e.g., plastic bottles, cardboard, old clothes, tin cans, etc.)
- Craft supplies (glue, scissors, tape, etc.)
- Label for naming the creation

Project Content:

- Make a useful or decorative classroom item (e.g., pen holder, wall hanging, desk organizer, mini planter).
- Decorate with recycled elements and label the item with an environmental slogan.

• Encourage functionality and creativity.

Submission Report Must Include:

- Student name & roll number
- Materials used (list)
- 4–5 sentences on the inspiration or usefulness of the item
