To strengthen your child's understanding of verbs (doing words) in a creative and hands-on manner, we bring to you a unique craft-based activity titled: "Verb Vein - A 3D Tree of Actions" **1**. Take a piece of cardboard or thick chart paper as the base. 2. Cut out a thick tree branch using brown paper or cardboard and paste it across the cardboard as if it's coming from one side. 3. Next, cut out green leaves (from green paper/cardstock). You can make 10–15 leaves. 4. On each leaf, write one action word (verb). Example verbs: run, swim, dance, clap, eat, sing, read, jump, hop, write. 5. Paste the leaves on and around the branch so they look like they are growing from it, giving a 3D look. 6. Decorate the base neatly. You can use markers, glitter, or outlines to enhance

it.






