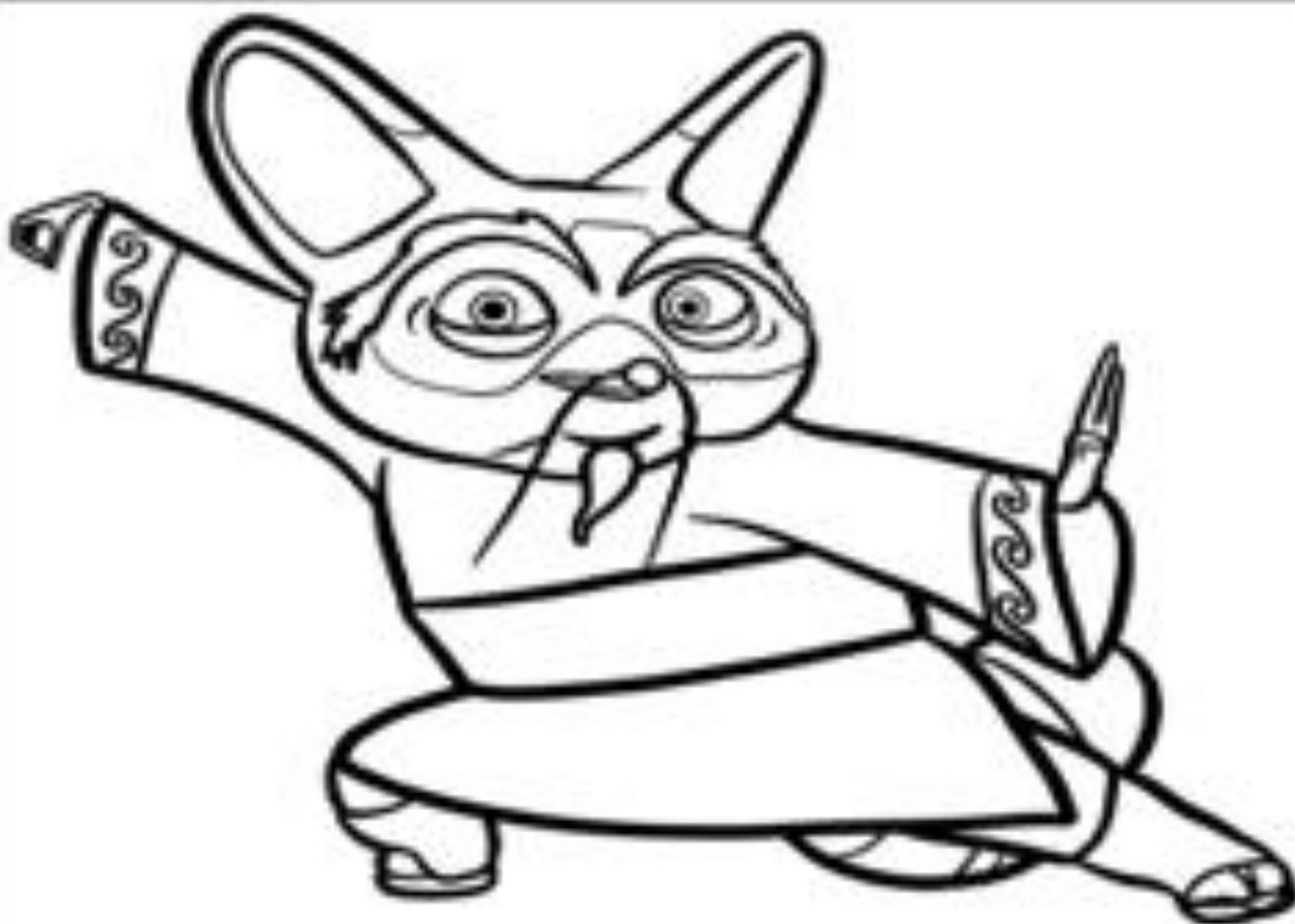

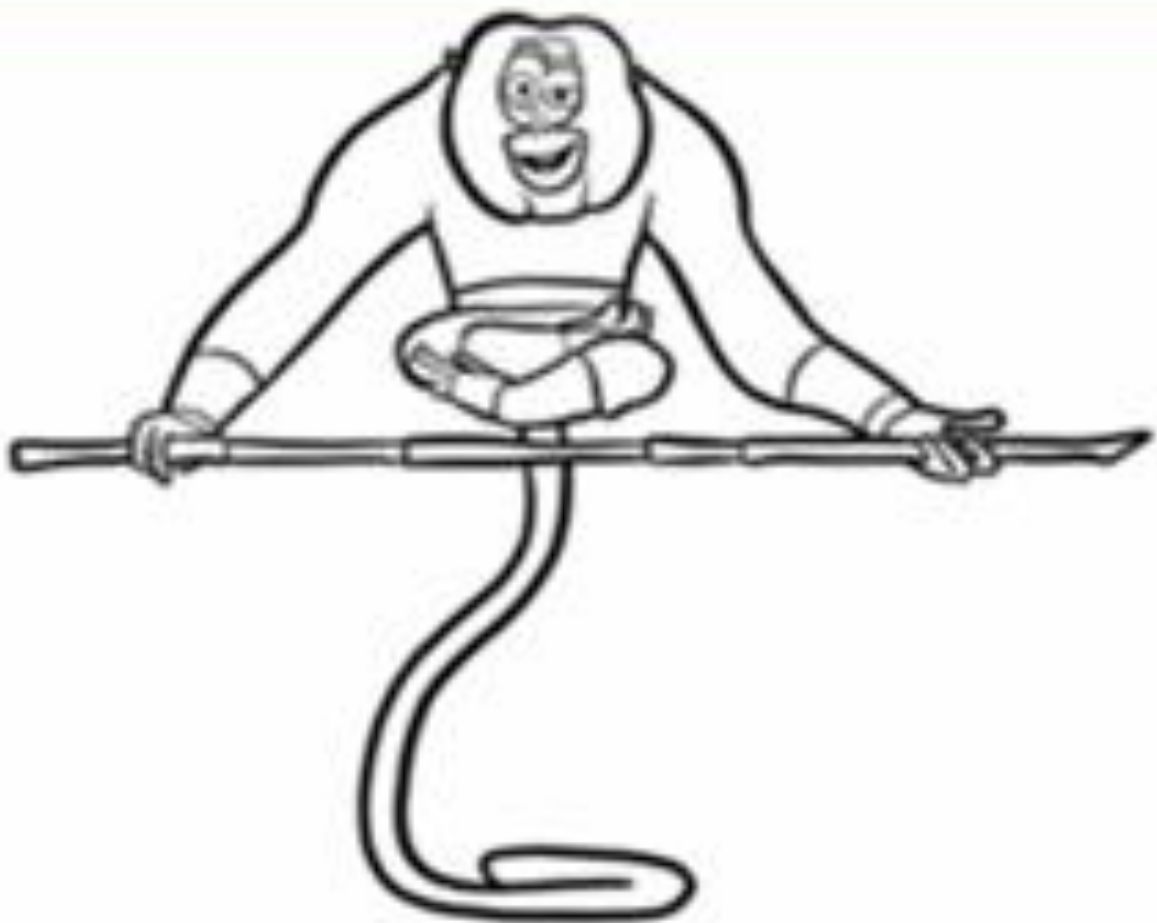

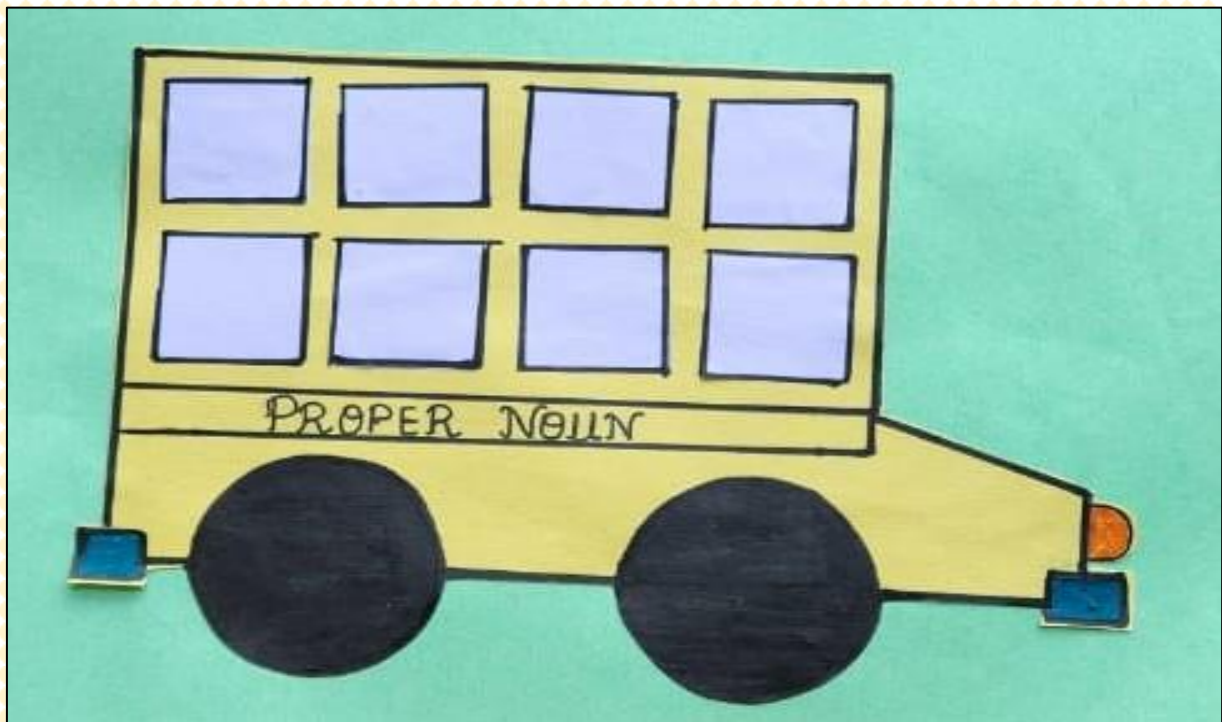




2. Noun Town Bus
