Homophone Wheel: Expand your World with Words

Steps to make the homophone wheel:

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1. Take two sheets of coloured pastel paper and cut each into equal circles.
 2. Fold one of the circles into eight sections. In each section, write a pair of homophones (for example, "see" and "sea").
 3. Continue this process until all eight sections contain a different pair of homophones.
 4. For the second circle, cut out a section that corresponds in size to each section of the first circle.
 5. Place the second circle on top of the first circle and use the cut-out sections to read the homophones through the openings.





The Place Value Accordion helps students understand place value and expanded notation.






