The main objective of the summit was to bring design into dialogue with ethics and natural intelligence.

The topic of presentation of our team was Public Health: Access and Quality. Our team members Atharv Saxena (XII-C), Tasia Anand (XII-D), Ashni Ahlawat (XI-B), Udayan Gera (X-G) and Saumya Bora (IX-F) under the guidance of their teacher Ms. Puja Sehgal, gave an impressive presentation which included well studied data collected on the basis of a large scale survey. DPS Dwarka emerged as the Winner of the Summit, DPS Vasant Kunj as the First runner-up and DPS RK Puram as the Second runner-up.

It was a matter of immense pride as the team basked in the moment of glory holding the trophy up to the crowd along with a cash prize of ₹50,000/-.

## > GOING BEYOND TEXTBOOKS

## Webinars/Workshops/Educational Trips organized for students

- 4 students of DPS Dwarka along with Ms. Samdisha Alagh (PGT Psychology)
   Ms. Smritika Saggi (School Counsellor) were selected to attend 'Adolescents Peer Educators Life Skills Leadership Programme' from 01-05 April 2024 organized by CBSE.
- On 12 April 2024, the school organized a workshop by Mr. Rajesh Mishra, Founder Director of GUIDE4CAREERS. The session, titled 'The Ecosystem-Careers after 12<sup>th</sup> Grade,' catered specifically to students in classes 11th and 12th. Its primary focus was to delve into the intricacies of the ecosystem of career opportunities available after completing 12<sup>th</sup>grade.
- DPS Dwarka organized a workshop in collaboration with Jamboree on 15 April 2024. The workshop aimed to equip students of 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grades with essential skills and knowledge to build effective profiles for future academic and career pursuits. The objective was to provide guidance and resources for individuals seeking to pursue careers abroad, focusing on essential steps and considerations for successful international career development. The resource person Mr. Vineet Gupta, Co-founder of Jamboree, brought his wealth of expertise and experience to the session, captivating the audience with his insights and wisdom.
- On 18 April 2024, Abhay Maheshwari, an alumnus of DPS Dwarka, delivered an enriching talk to the students of Class XI in the school auditorium. The students were visibly thrilled and captivated by his engaging storytelling skills and compelling narrative. Abhay, known for his prowess as a podcaster and storyteller, expertly wove anecdotes from his own life, emphasizing the importance of courage, perseverance, and self-belief. He resonated well with the students, who are embarking on a new phase of their academic journey, having recently chosen their streams in science and humanities.

- The History Department of DPS Dwarka organized an educational trip to the National Museum for its students of Class VI from 23-25 April 2024. The guided tour began with the instructor explaining the details of sculpture of Suryadeva, standing tall in the central foyer. Thereafter the groups moved to the famous Harappan gallery which quite literally brought the civilization back to life for the students. With its array of exhibits, ranging from gigantic vases to the petite figurine of the 'Dancing Girl', students were enthralled by the artefacts. Students were informed of the burial practices of the Harappans with a special mention for the skeletal remains of a woman from the site of Rakhigarhi.
- A workshop on 'New Age Careers' was conducted for the students of Class XII on 25 April 2024 in school auditorium. The session was led by Mr. Krishna from Pearl Academy and Ms. Aparna from UPES. The workshop was highly engaging, with an enthusiastic audience eager to explore new opportunities in the evolving job market. Participants were informed about emerging career paths and trends in various industries.
- A Robotics Orientation Session was conducted by the members of Robodex Club for students of Class VI students on 30 April 2024. Under the guidance of teachers, senior members of the club conducted the orientation session. A presentation was showcased briefing about the club activities followed by a PPT and video on how to construct a wired robotic car. The highlight of the session was a live demonstration of a robotic car. The enthusiasm and excitement of the young technocrats in the making was immense.
- To help children manage their emotions effectively, a workshop on 'Behavioural Issues' was conducted by NIE for Class V on 06 May 2024. As a former science student, Kriti's career trajectory exemplifies the pursuit of passion and the exploration of unconventional paths. She demonstrated excellence in her studies, laying a strong foundation for her future endeavours. Despite her background in science, she harboured a deep-seated passion for textiles and the rich cultural tapestry of India.

- The rise in temperature often leads to instances of heat related illnesses like exhaustion, dehydration, and vomiting. To spread awareness and prevent students from falling ill, teachers of Classes III to V conducted a session on Preparedness to Prevent Heat Related Illness (HRI) on 10 May 2024. Teachers discussed the role of water in regulating body temperature and preventing dehydration. The class discussion ended with an interactive Q & A session which allowed participants to ask questions and share personal experiences related to heat safety. A hands-on Poster Making Activity to highlight prevention strategies was also carried out.
