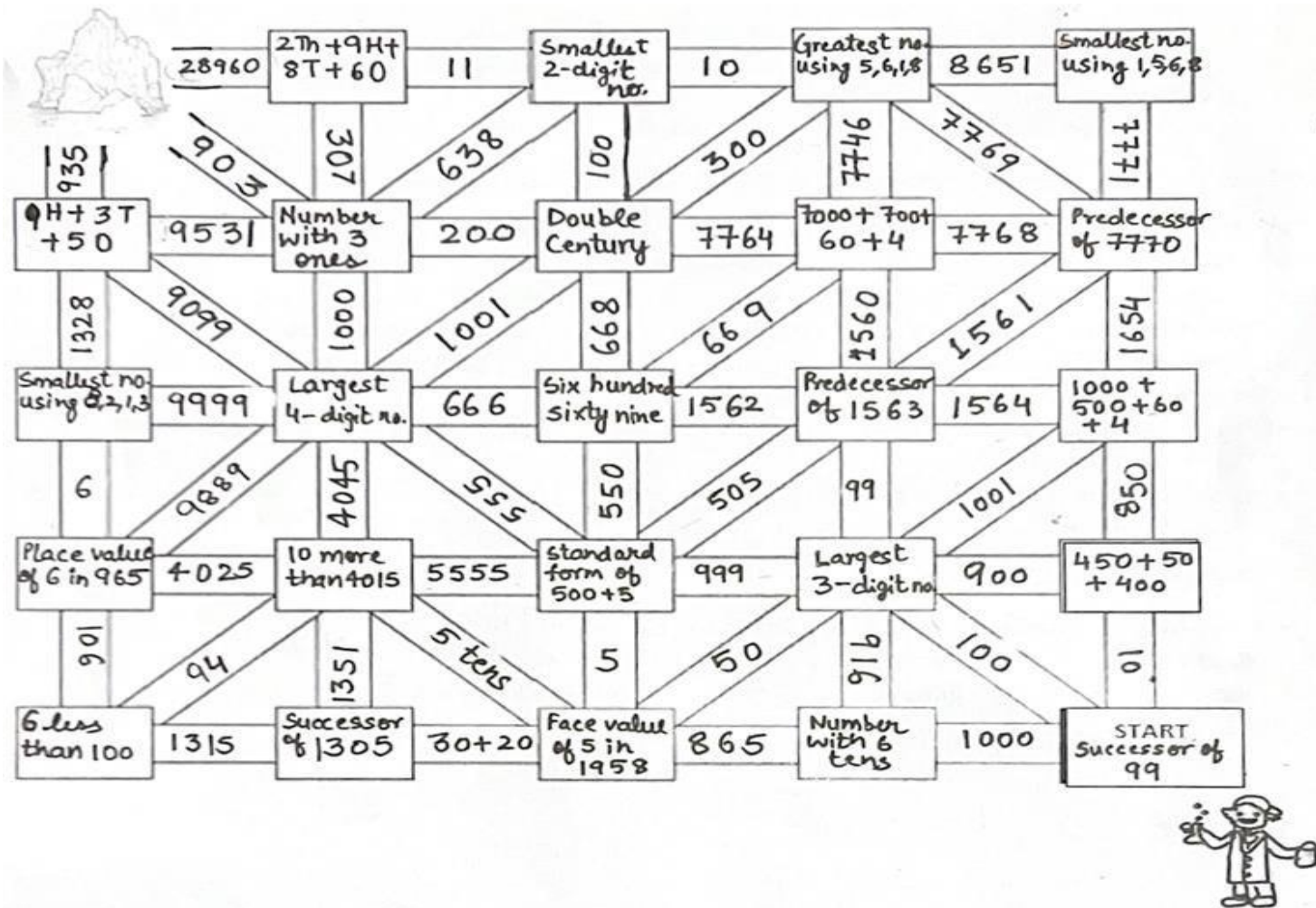

MATHEMATICS

TASK 1: GLACIER GAMBIT

Mr. Sammy is a scientist who needs to get to a glacier to collect some data for research to preserve it. Take print of the given maze on an A3 size sheet, get it laminated , then use different colour sketch pens and help the scientist find his way to reach the glacier by following the path of correct answers through the maze. Determine the answer in each box and follow the correct answer to the next box.



TASK 2: MATHEVENTURE: SLIDE & SOLVE

Design a Snakes & Ladders Board game that will help in revising Number System concepts in a play way manner. You may use the concept of Place, Place Value, Face Value, Successor, Predecessor, Odd – Even Numbers, Number Names, Expanded, Standard Form etc. Size : at least 10 inches × 10 inches. Draw a grid of 10 × 10 squares on the cardboard to make 100 boxes. Number them from 1 to 100, starting from the bottom left. Draw 6 ladders and 6 snakes, placing them at different positions. You can also download the template or refer to NCERT (Maths Mela) Book page no. – 17 for the same.

Hints to use Number Concepts that can be included in the Rule book & Board:

- **Even numbers/ Odd numbers :** Climb a small ladder or miss a turn or roll again.
- **Skip Counting:** Place a ladder on multiples of 5 or 10.
- **Place Value:** Squares that are 2-digit numbers with the same digit. (Eg : 22 or 33) give a bonus move.
- **Number Names:** On some squares write Number names and make a rule to read it aloud.
- **Greatest/Smallest Digit :** On some squares, write a question like ‘What is the Greatest digit in 58?’ If answered correctly, move ahead 2 steps.
- **Successor/Predecessor :** On some squares, write a question like ‘What is the predecessor of 44?’ If answered correctly, get a free move.
- **Ascending/Descending Order:** On some squares mark a star, if the player lands on it they have to answer question related to ascending or descending order.
- Create a stack of Math Question Cards to draw from if you land on some special squares.

THE WORLD AROUND US

Task 1: 3-D POSTER (size – A3)

Cooperatives lead to environmental initiatives promoting sustainable practices and renewable energy to combat climate change. Be like a cooperative and think mindfully how can we rescue Glaciers and create a 3D Poster entitled ‘Glacier Rescue: Before We Harm, After We Help!’

Materials Needed: Cardboard (for base), Cotton balls or white clay (glaciers), Blue paper/yarn (rivers/lakes), Green, brown, black paper (grass, dry land, smoke), Toy cars or printed cut-outs (animals, people, factories), Popsicle sticks, toothpicks (for labels), Glue, scissors, ruler, pencil

How to prepare ?

Step 1: Prepare the Base using a large cardboard piece and draw a line down the center to divide it in two.

Step 2: On Left Side show before preservation

- **Glacier:** Use few cotton balls to show a shrinking glacier.
- **Damaged Land:** Stick brown paper for dry land and torn trees.
- **Pollution:** Add black cotton on toy cars/factory cut-outs.
- **Wildlife:** Place animal cut-outs far from glacier to show displacement.
- **Labels:** “Melting Glacier”, “Pollution”, “No Trees”, “Dirty Water”, etc.

Step 3: On Right Side show after Preservation

- **Healthy Glacier:** Use more cotton balls or white clay for a big glacier.
- **Greenery:** Add green paper trees, twigs, dried leaves.
- **Clean Water:** Use blue paper/yarn to make a clean river.
- **Animals & People:** Place animals near glacier. Add stick figures biking, planting trees, etc.
- **Renewables:** Make solar panels from bottle caps, windmills from paper.
- **Labels:** “Healthy Glacier”, “Clean Air & Water”, “Happy Animals”, “Solar Panel”, etc.
