
PACE – Alliance of Commerce and Entrepreneurship The Commerce Club







FGEUS The Photography Club






The Chemistry Club


EUMARIUM The English Language and Literature Club




Politico promotes political awareness, civic responsibility and critical thinking through engaging activities like debates, mock parliaments, quizzes and campaign simulations.

The club helps students hone their legal skills, public speaking and critical analysis thus creating a foundation for aspiring legal professionals.






ROBODEX The Robotics Club
