FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL



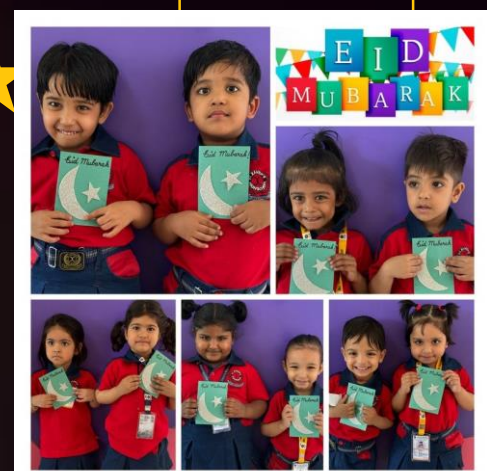

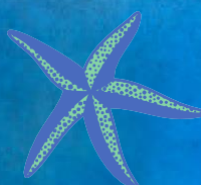




EARTH DAY
