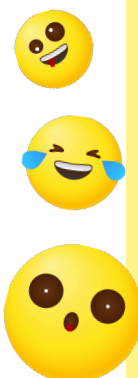

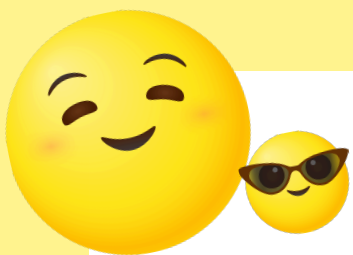
Celebrating World Emoji Day

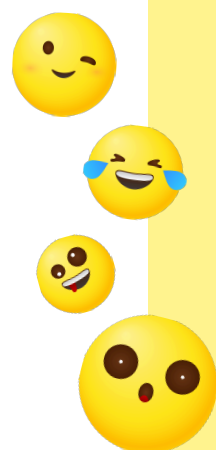

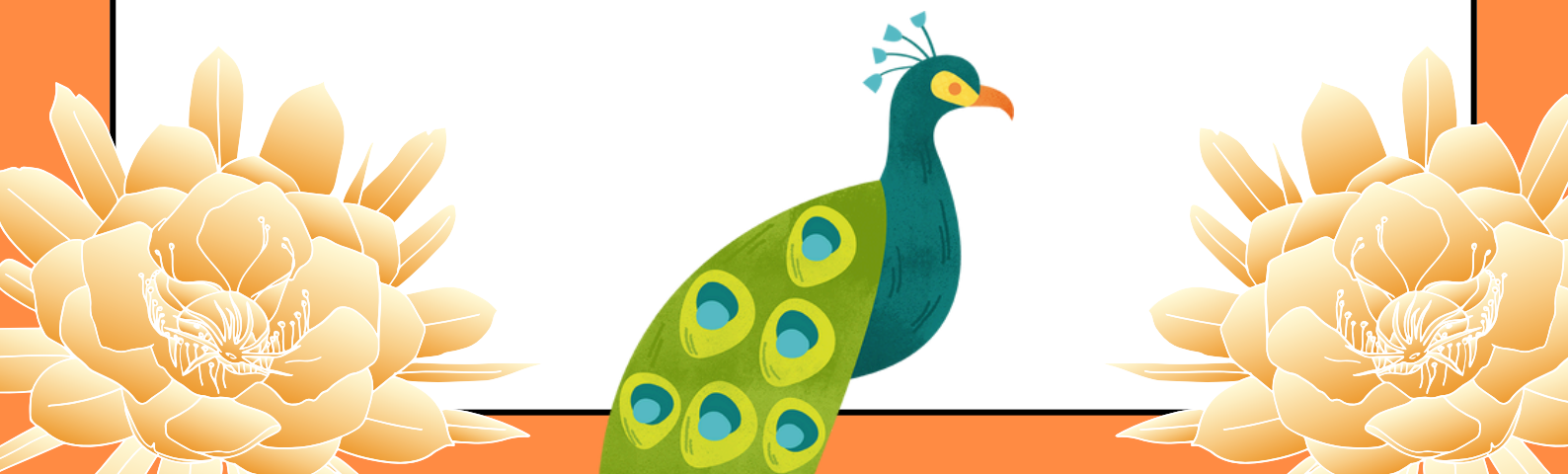

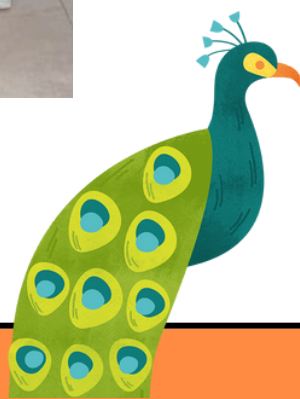


Independence Day Celebration

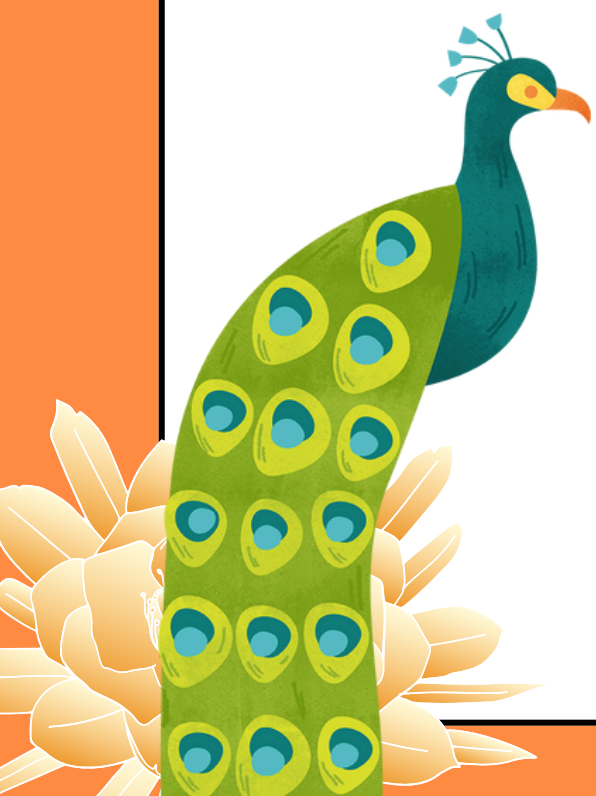

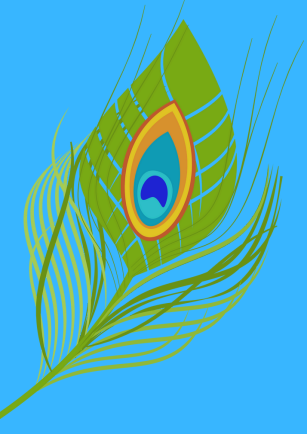
