recognizing the contributions autistic people make to their communities and the world at large.

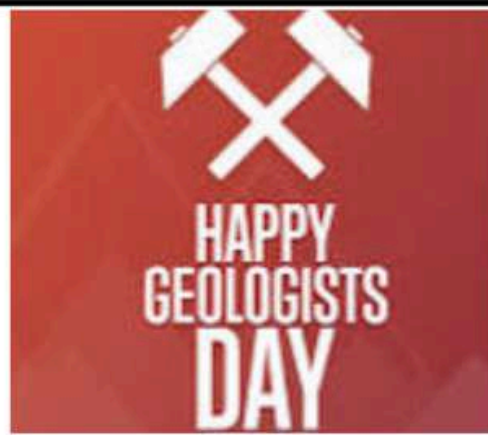


The 2025 observance, under the theme "Advancing Neurodiversity and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)"

World Table Tennis Day! First held in 2015, World Table Tennis Day (WTTD) is celebrated annually on 6 April



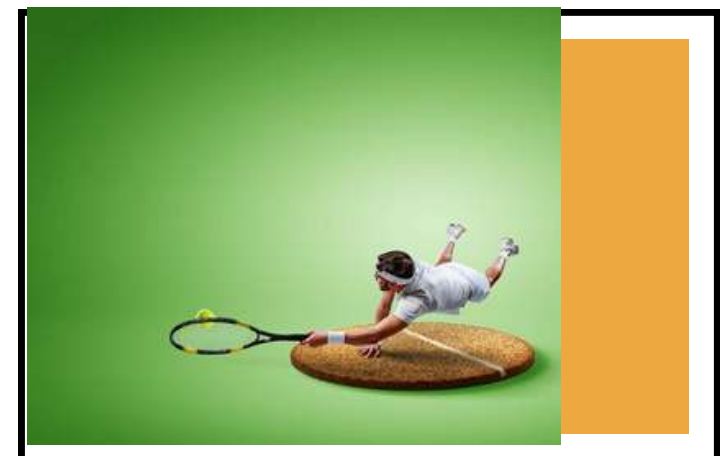
Year 2025, theme is Diversity and Inclusion

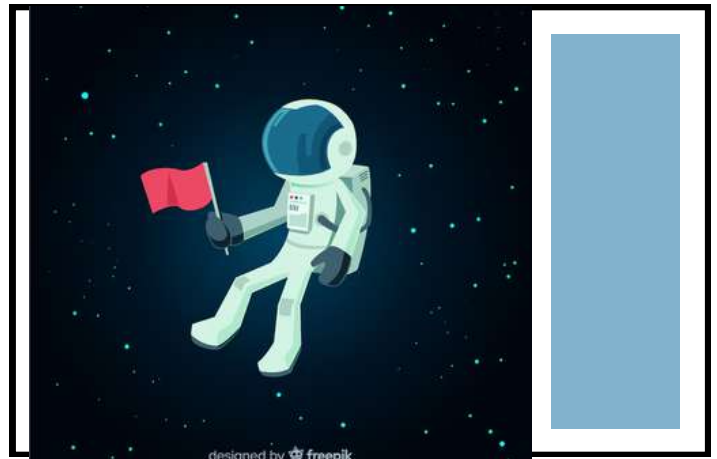
The International Day of Human Space Flight is celebrated on 12 April

Before the human space flight, Laika a stray mongrel from the streets of Moscow was sent on a Sputnik 2 on 3 November 1957.

She died a few hours after the launch during the fourth orbit of the Sputnik. The first living organisms to be safely recovered after a spaceflight were two dogs (named Belka and Strelka), one rabbit, two rats, forty mice, and other biological specimens.

They were launched aboard a Soviet Korabl-Sputnik 2 spacecraft on 20 August 1960, and were safely recovered after completing 17 orbits in about 24 hours.

Every year on 22 April, we've celebrated Earth Day. Earth Day, established in 1970, has been used to highlight our planet's environmental challenges and raise awareness of the importance of protecting our world for future generations.

Earth happens to orbit the sun within the so-called "Goldilocks zone," where temperatures are just right to maintain liquid water on our planet's surface.

Coral reefs are not only beautiful natural wonders, but also the largest living structure on Earth. These underwater ecosystems are made up of colonies of tiny animals called coral polyps, which build calcium carbonate skeletons that accumulate over time and form the complex structures.

Earth, our home planet, is the third from the Sun, a rocky planet with a dynamic surface, a unique atmosphere, and is the only known place in the solar system to harbor life, with 70% of its surface covered in water.

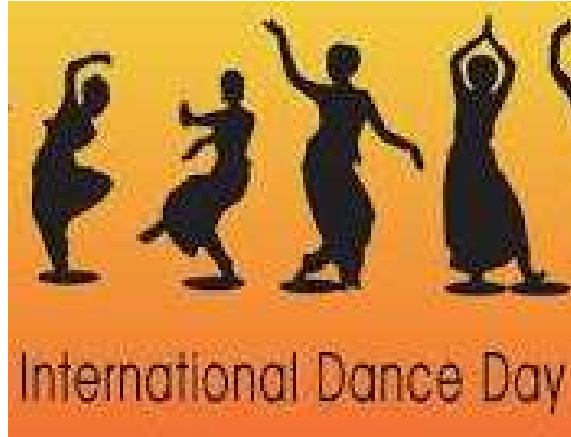
