All 41 Workers Evacuated in Uttarakhand Tunnel After 17 days

November 23, 2023

On November 23, 2023, after 17 harrowing days trapped in a tunnel, all 41 workers were successfully rescued from the collapsed Silkyara-Barkot tunnel in Uttarakhand, India. The workers were engaged in the construction of the Silkyara-Dandalgaon tunnel on the Brahmkaal-Yamunotri highway when a landslide caused portions of the tunnel to collapse on the day of Diwali, November 12, 2023.

The rescue operation, stretching over two weeks, involved a multi-agency effort to reach the trapped workers. Later, a combination of horizontal and vertical drilling techniques was employed, involving planning by experts and the introduction of rat-hole miners for manual excavation through narrow pipes. After numerous hurdles and a final push on November 28, the rat-hole miners successfully reached the trapped workers, drilling through rocks and debris and rescued them. The workers were taken to hospital for necessary medical attention, marking the end of a challenging and triumphant rescue mission.

India's Aditya-L1 Recorded First-Ever Sight of Solar Flares

November 9, 2023

ISRO's maiden solar mission, Aditya L1, has marked a significant achievement by capturing its first high-energy X-ray glimpse of solar flares. During its initial observation period starting from around October 29, the High Energy L1 Orbiting X-ray Spectrometer (HEL1OS) on board the Aditya-L1 spacecraft recorded the impulsive phase of solar flares. A solar flare is a sudden brightening of the solar atmosphere.

December 3, 2023

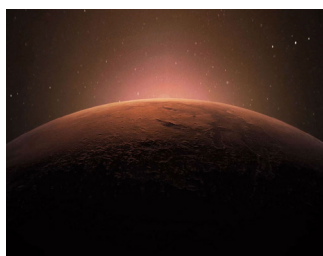

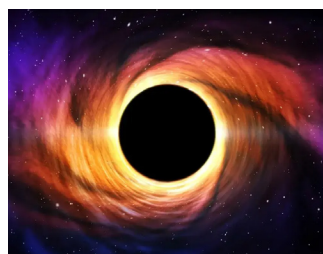

November 8, 2023

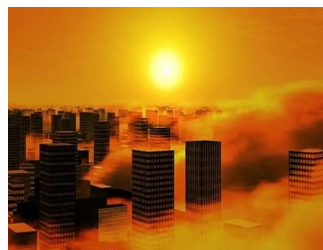

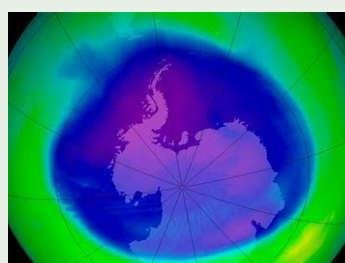

November 23, 2023

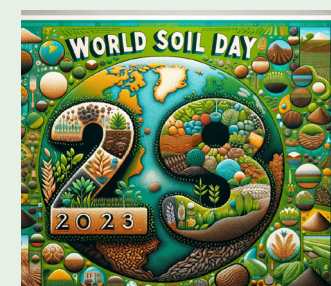

Ruturaj Gaikwad Becomes the Fastest Indian to Score 4,000 Runs in Men's T20

December 02, 2023

Ruturaj Gaikwad, the talented Indian cricketer, has achieved a remarkable milestone in men's T20 cricket. In the fourth T20I against Australia at the Shaheed Veer Narayan Singh International Stadium in Raipur, Gaikwad engraved his name in the record books by becoming the fastest Indian to amass 4,000 runs in the shortest format of the game.

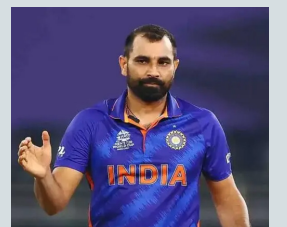

November 28, 2023

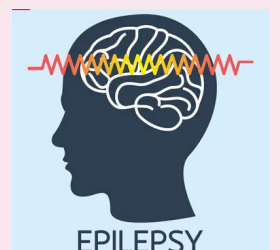
