# A Motivational Speech by Didi Krishna Kumari Ji

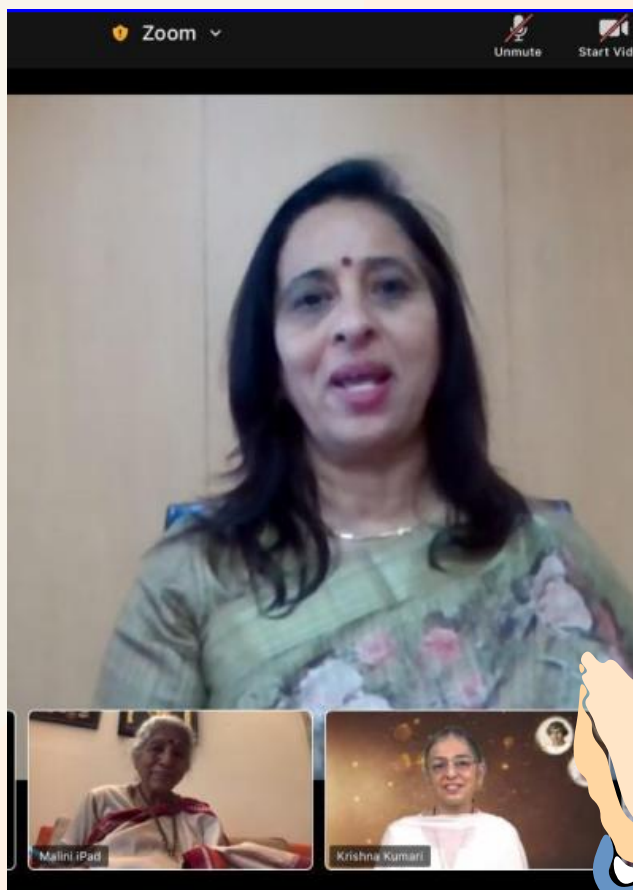
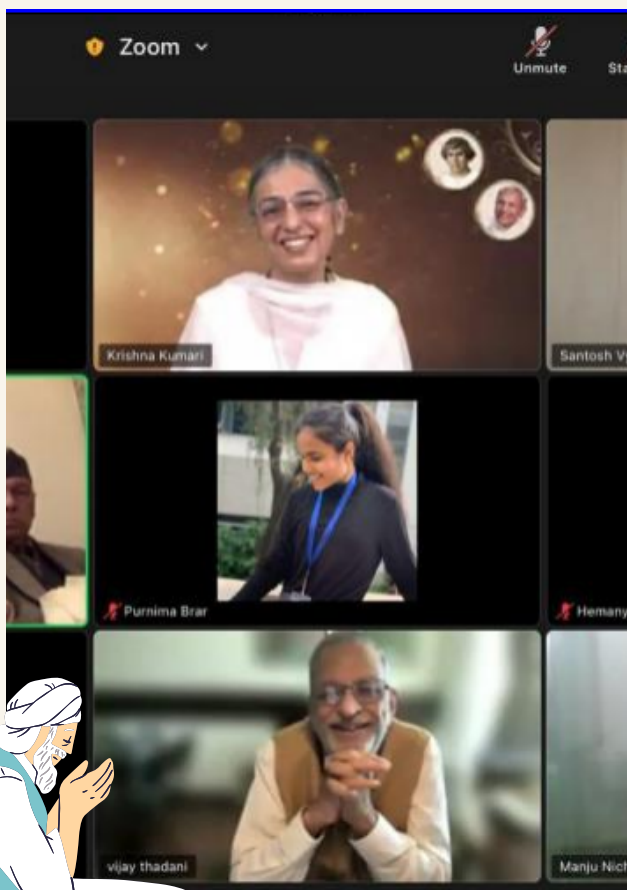

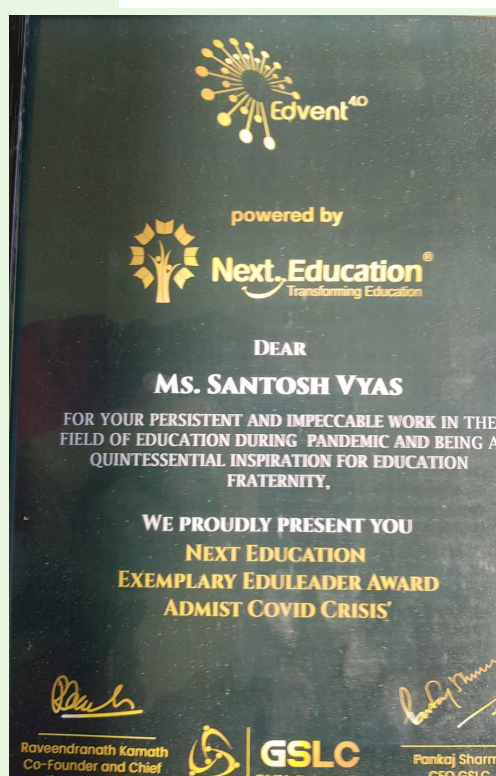

# Happy Teachers Create Happy Classrooms



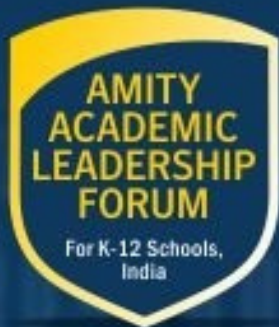
A classroom should be a space where happiness takes precedence, where children are always met with a smile and positivity. It is a space where their well-being is as important as their academic achievements.

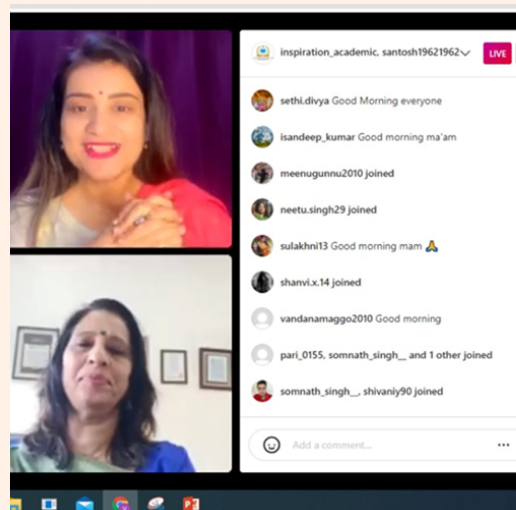

The day was a fiesta devoted to the years spent together with friends and teachers and reminisced joyous moments. It was a great time for them to refresh their memories and reflect upon their school life.



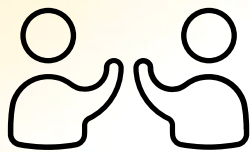

Ananya Pandey of grade XI won the 'Best Delegate award.' She received a certificate, letter of recommendation and cash prize for the same.

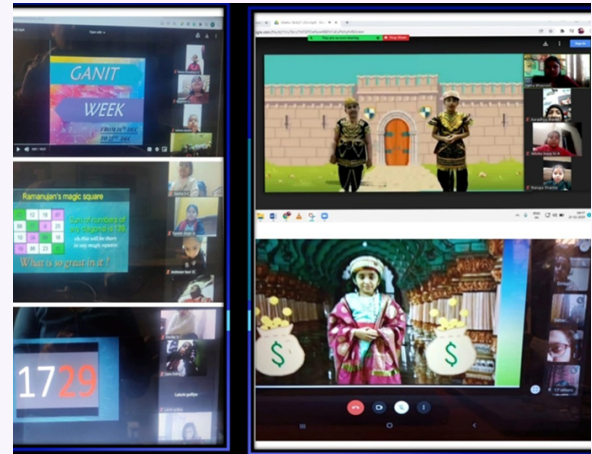


# Ganit Week Celebrations

# Delhi State School Games 2021-22, Chess

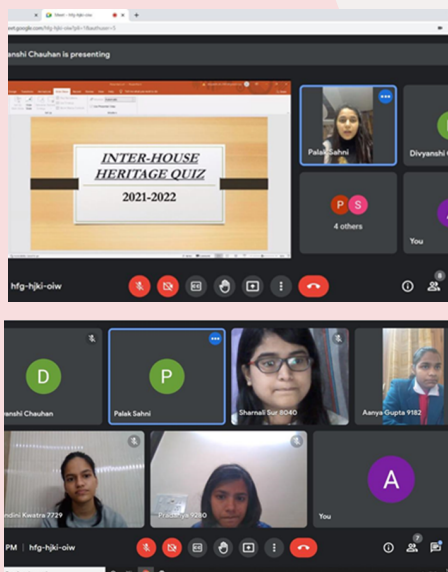

# Basant Panchami Celebrations

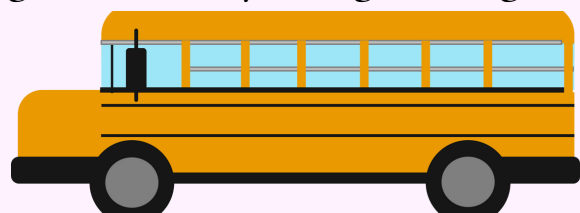
