


OUR SCHOOL HOSTED AN ENGAGING AND INSIGHTFUL INTRA-SCHOOL MODEL UNITED NATIONS (MUN) FOCUSED ON VARIOUS PRESSING GLOBAL ISSUES. THE EVENT BROUGHT TOGETHER STUDENTS FROM DIVERSE GRADES TO SIMULATE THE WORKINGS OF THE UNITED NATIONS, FOSTERING CRITICAL THINKING AND DIPLOMATIC SKILLS. THE UNGA SESSION CONCENTRATED ON REDEFINING TERRITORIAL LANDSCAPES, SPECIFICALLY ADDRESSING THE ONGOING SOUTH CHINA SEA CONFLICT. IN THE UNSC DISCUSSIONS, DELEGATES ADDRESSED SECURITY CONCERNS IN THE SOUTH CHINA SEA, FOCUSING ON MILITARY BUILD-UP AND THE IMPLICATIONS FOR REGIONAL SECURITY.

THE UNCSW ENGAGED IN A CRUCIAL DIALOGUE ABOUT THE ELECTORAL BOND ISSUE, PARTICULARLY IN LIGHT OF THE LOK SABHA ELECTIONS. THE AIPPM SESSION ALLOWED STUDENTS TO ROLE-PLAY VARIOUS POLITICAL PARTY REPRESENTATIVES, DISCUSSING STRATEGIES FOR FOSTERING INCLUSIVE GOVERNANCE AND ADDRESSING SOCIO-ECONOMIC DISPARITIES. DELEGATES PROPOSED SOLUTIONS SUCH AS EARLY WARNING SYSTEMS, INFRASTRUCTURAL IMPROVEMENTS, AND SUSTAINABLE LAND-USE PLANNING TO SAFEGUARD VULNERABLE COMMUNITIES.



SPACE WORKSHOP






KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS

INTER-HOUSE BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT




