EXCURSIONS

Subject Enrichment

Enrichment activities encourages students to take a more expansive or in depth look on subjects to a more meaningful facet of the real world. Enrichment promotes critical thinking and problem solving skills, improve students ability to concentrate and make learning more meaningful, valuable and rewarding.

Enrichment activities are fun which helps students to become more engaged in their learning and retain more information.

NUMERACY- our learners strengthened their mathematical skills through engaging hands-on activities. They explored skip counting by 2s, 3s, and 5s using the Hopscotch Caterpillar Activity, making learning both fun and interactive. They also practiced single-digit addition and subtraction, enhancing their problem-solving abilities. The Hit the Glass Game made subtraction an exciting and practical experience.

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LITERACY- This quarter in Literacy, our learners explored exciting phonics concepts to strengthen their reading and spelling skills. They practiced L blends and S blends, enhancing their ability to recognize and pronounce blended sounds. They also learned about digraphs, focusing on letter combinations that create unique sounds. Engaging activities like the Whale Activity for wh and the Phone Activity for ph made learning fun and interactive.

HINDI- This quarter in Hindi, our learners expanded their vocabulary by practicing three- and four-letter words and forming simple sentences using them. They strengthened their reading skills through engaging activities with Vyanjan flashcards, helping them recognize and recall letters effortlessly.



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EVS



This quarter in EVS, our learners explored exciting themes that connected them to the world around them. They discovered the roles of community helpers through engaging activities to understand their importance. Exploring types of food and the food pyramid, they learned about healthy eating and making nutritious choices. They also delved into the fascinating world of animals, identifying their habitats and unique characteristics. Through interactive discussions, hands-on activities, and storytelling, learners developed curiosity, awareness, and appreciation for their surroundings, making this quarter a meaningful and enriching learning experience.
