



DUSSEHRA CELEBRATIONS ASSEMBLY BY GRADE IV-C



XAVERIANS OF GRADE IV-C CONDUCTED A SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON 10TH OCTOBER, 2024 TO CELEBRATE THE AUSPICIOUS FESTIVAL OF DUSSEHRA, SIGNIFYING THE VICTORY OF GOOD OVER EVIL THE ASSEMBLY WAS AN ENLIGHTENING AND VIBRANT EVENT, FILLED WITH CULTURAL LEARNING AND MORAL LESSONS DRAWN FROM ONE OF INDIA'S GREATEST EPICS, THE RAMAYANA.

DIWALI CELEBRATIONS RANGOLI MAKING COMPETITION




POCSO WORKSHOP

ON 29TH OCTOBER 2024, ST. XAVIER'S HIGH SCHOOL ORGANIZED A COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING SESSION ON THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM SEXUAL OFFENCES (POCSO) ACT FOR ITS TEACHING STAFF. THE SESSION AIMED TO CREATE AWARENESS AMONG TEACHERS ABOUT THE PROVISIONS OF THE POCSO ACT AND EQUIP THEM TO SAFEGUARD THE RIGHTS AND WELL-BEING OF CHILDREN.

THE SESSION INCLUDED INTERACTIVE ACTIVITIES, CASE STUDY DISCUSSIONS, AND A Q&A ROUND WHERE TEACHERS SHARED THEIR CONCERNS AND SOUGHT CLARITY ON PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS OF THE ACT.

THE WORKSHOP CONCLUDED WITH AN EMPHASIS ON THE COLLECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY OF EDUCATORS TO ACT AS VIGILANT PROTECTORS OF CHILDREN'S RIGHTS. TEACHERS EXPRESSED THEIR GRATITUDE FOR THE INSIGHTFUL SESSION, WHICH REINFORCED THEIR COMMITMENT TO FOSTERING A SAFE AND NURTURING ENVIRONMENT FOR STUDENTS.





SCIENCE EXPERIMENT









THE PRIMARY SECTION'S SCIENCE CLUB CONDUCTED AN ENGAGING EXPERIMENT ON FRIDAY, 8TH NOVEMBER 2024 ON THE DISPERSION OF LIGHT THROUGH A GLASS PRISM, WHICH AIMED TO DEEPEN STUDENTS' UNDERSTANDING OF LIGHT BEHAVIOR, ESPECIALLY THE DISPERSION AND SCATTERING THAT LEAD TO RAINBOW FORMATION.

BY UNDERSTANDING THE CONCEPT OF SCATTERING OF LIGHT, STUDENTS EXPLORED ABOUT LIGHT THAT AS IT PASSES THROUGH DIFFERENT MEDIA, CAN SCATTER. THIS SCATTERING PLAYS A ROLE IN PHENOMENA LIKE THE BLUE SKY AND RAINBOWS. THE EXPERIMENT HELPED STUDENTS VISUALIZE HOW PARTICLES INTERACT WITH LIGHT, ESPECIALLY WHEN IT ENTERS A NEW MEDIUM. THE EXPERIMENT DEMONSTRATED THAT WHITE LIGHT CONSISTS OF VARIOUS COLORS—REPRESENTED AS VIBGYOR (VIOLET, INDIGO, BLUE, GREEN, YELLOW, ORANGE, RED)—WHICH SEPARATE WHEN PASSING THROUGH A PRISM DUE TO VARYING WAVELENGTHS. THE PRIMARY GOAL WAS TO SHOW STUDENTS THE RAINBOW-LIKE BAND FORMED WHEN WHITE LIGHT DISPERSES THROUGH A PRISM, CREATING A VISIBLE SPECTRUM. THIS VISUAL REPRESENTATION ALLOWED STUDENTS TO RELATE THE EXPERIMENT TO NATURAL RAINBOWS. THE EXPERIMENT ILLUSTRATED THE CONCEPT OF LIGHT REFRACTION AND HOW IT DISPERSES WHEN PASSING THROUGH A GLASS PRISM, SEPARATING INTO A RAINBOW BAND. STUDENTS LEARNED THAT EACH COLOR BENDS DIFFERENTLY DUE TO ITS WAVELENGTH, CREATING A RAINBOW ENDOWS.

THE EXPERIMENT EFFECTIVELY DEMONSTRATED THE DISPERSION OF LIGHT, ALLOWING STUDENTS TO VISUALIZE A MINI RAINBOW AND UNDERSTAND LIGHT'S BEHAVIOR IN NEW ENVIRONMENTS. IT ENCOURAGED CURIOSITY ABOUT LIGHT AND COLOR IN THE NATURAL WORLD, DEEPENING THEIR GRASP OF FOUNDATIONAL SCIENTIFIC PRINCIPLES.

RUSSIAN-CHINESE-INDO EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

RUSSIAN-CHINESE-INDO EXCHANGE PROGRAMME BROUGHT TOGETHER STUDENTS FROM ST. XAVIER'S HIGH SCHOOL, SECTOR 49, INDIA, LINCHUAN XINGHUIDAO SCHOOL FROM BEIJING, CHINA, AND MBGEI EDUCATIONAL CENTRE NO. 7 FROM RUSSIA IN A UNIQUE AND INTERACTIVE CELEBRATION OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE. THE STUDENTS SHOWCASED THEIR PRIMARY EDUCATION SYSTEMS THROUGH A SERIES OF ENGAGING VIDEO PRESENTATIONS, POWERPOINT SLIDES, AND LIVE DEMONSTRATIONS, OFFERING A GLIMPSE INTO THE DISTINCT YET COMPARABLE ASPECTS OF SCHOOLING IN EACH COUNTRY.

IN ADDITION TO THE EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATIONS, THE STUDENTS PARTICIPATED IN A LIVELY "GUESS THE IDIOM" GAME, WHERE EACH GROUP INTRODUCED IDIOMATIC EXPRESSIONS FROM THEIR NATIVE LANGUAGES RUSSIAN, CHINESE, AND HINDI—WHILE THE OTHERS TRIED TO DECIPHER THEIR MEANINGS. THIS FUN, INTERACTIVE GAME ENCOURAGED LANGUAGE LEARNING AND SPARKED CURIOSITY ABOUT THE NUANCES OF EACH CULTURE'S EXPRESSIONS.

THE CULTURAL EXCHANGE TOOK CENTER STAGE WITH MUSICAL PERFORMANCES. THE RUSSIAN STUDENTS PERFORMED SONGS IN THEIR NATIVE LANGUAGE, WHILE THE STUDENTS FROM ST. XAVIER'S HIGH SCHOOL SHOWCASED SONGS IN HINDI, CHINESE AND RUSSIAN, CREATING A VIBRANT ATMOSPHERE OF SHARED MUSIC AND CULTURAL CELEBRATION. THE EVENT ALSO FEATURED AN EXCITING LANGUAGE-LEARNING SESSION, WHERE STUDENTS LEARNED SIMPLE GREETINGS IN ALL THREE LANGUAGES, STRENGTHENING THE BONDS OF FRIENDSHIP AND CROSS-CULTURAL UNDERSTANDING.

THE ENTIRE SESSION WAS FILLED WITH JOY, ENTHUSIASM AND A SPIRIT OF COLLABORATION, WITH EVERYONE EAGERLY LOOKING FORWARD TO MORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR SUCH ENRICHING EXCHANGES. THE EVENT NOT ONLY HIGHLIGHTED THE IMPORTANCE OF LANGUAGE AND EDUCATION IN BUILDING GLOBAL CONNECTIONS BUT ALSO EMPHASIZED THE SHARED JOY OF LEARNING AND INTERACTING ACROSS CULTURAL BOUNDARIES.



LOOKING BACK, WE ARE EQUALLY THRILLED THAT THIS JOURNEY OF MUTUAL LEARNING EXTENDED TO OUR STUDENTS, WHO EMBARKED ON THEIR OWN CULTURAL EXPLORATION IN MARCH-APRIL 2025 WITH A RECIPROCAL VISIT TO RUSSIA. THIS EXCHANGE OFFERED OUR CHILDREN A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO IMMERSE THEMSELVES IN RUSSIAN CULTURE, STRENGTHENING THE BONDS AND UNDERSTANDING CULTIVATED DURING THIS VISIT.

THE INDO-RUSSIAN EXCHANGE PROGRAM WAS A SIGNIFICANT STEP TOWARD DEVELOPING GLOBALLY AWARE AND CULTURALLY EMPATHETIC INDIVIDUALS. WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT THE FRIENDSHIPS AND INSIGHTS GAINED THROUGH THIS EXPERIENCE ENRICHED OUR STUDENTS' LIVES, FOSTERING A SPIRIT OF INTERNATIONAL UNITY AND UNDERSTANDING.





THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE EVENT WAS THE VARIETY OF ITEMS
PRESENTED BY THE TEACHERS FOR THE CHILDREN. THE MUSIC
TEACHERS ENTHRALLED THE AUDIENCE WITH MELODIOUS SONGS,
AND A VIBRANT MUSICAL PERFORMANCE ADDED RHYTHM AND
ENERGY TO THE CELEBRATIONS. THE TEACHERS ALSO STAGED A
DELIGHTFUL SKIT THAT CAPTIVATED THE STUDENTS AND CONVEYED
THE SPIRIT OF CHILDREN'S DAY WITH A MEANINGFUL MESSAGE.

POEMS DEDICATED TO CHILDREN AND THEIR IMPORTANCE WERE RECITED IN BOTH HINDI AND ENGLISH, LEAVING THE AUDIENCE INSPIRED. THE PERFORMANCES NOT ONLY BROUGHT SMILES TO THE STUDENTS' FACES BUT ALSO REINFORCED THE BOND BETWEEN TEACHERS AND THEIR BELOVED LEARNERS.




