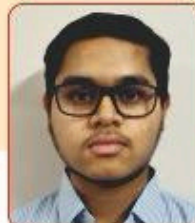

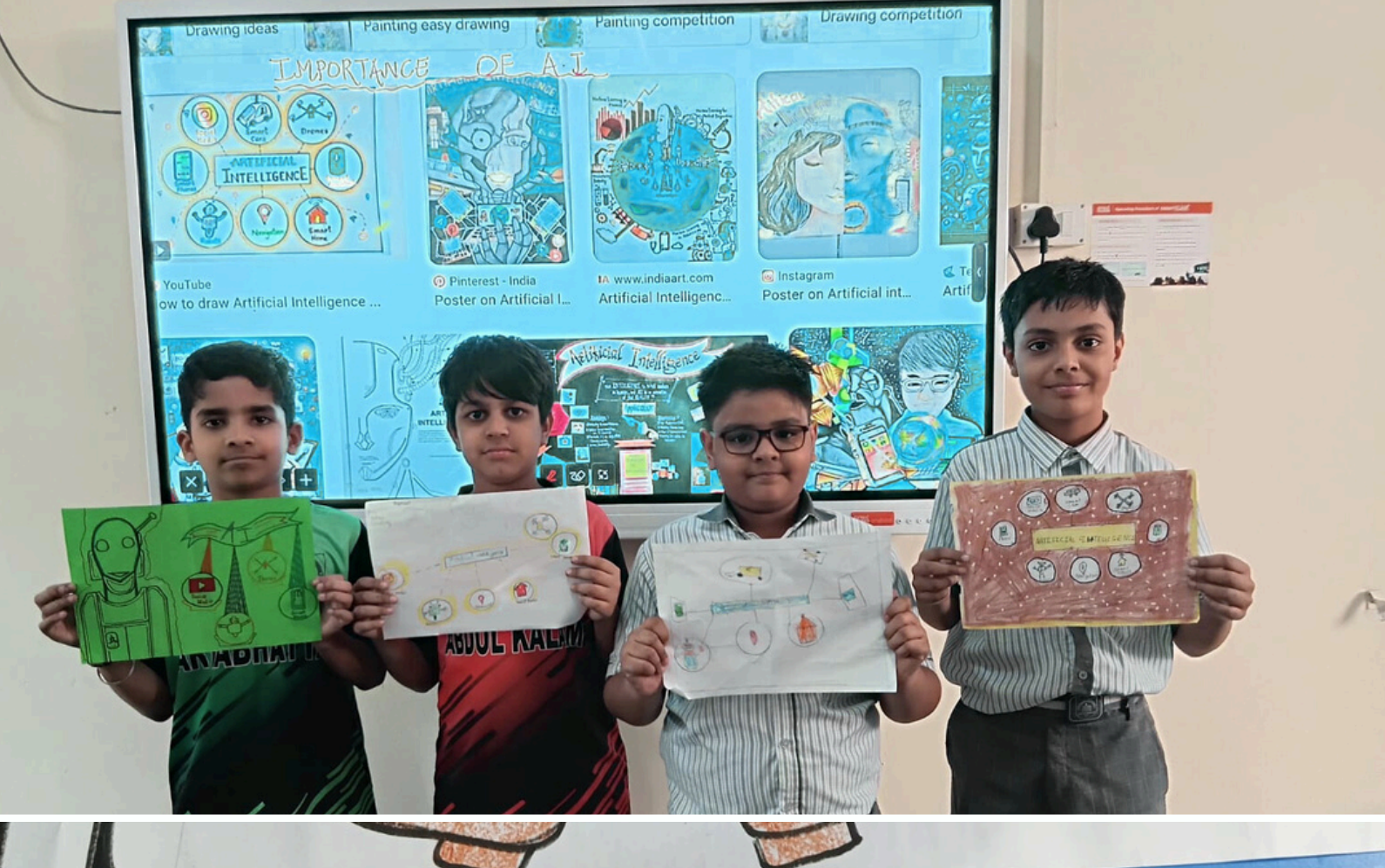

PAUSE & BREATHE: A YOGA RETREAT FOR EDUCATORS

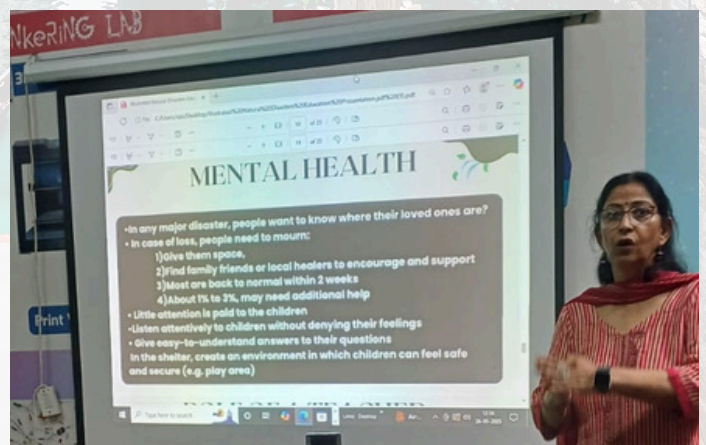
HARMONY WITHIN:

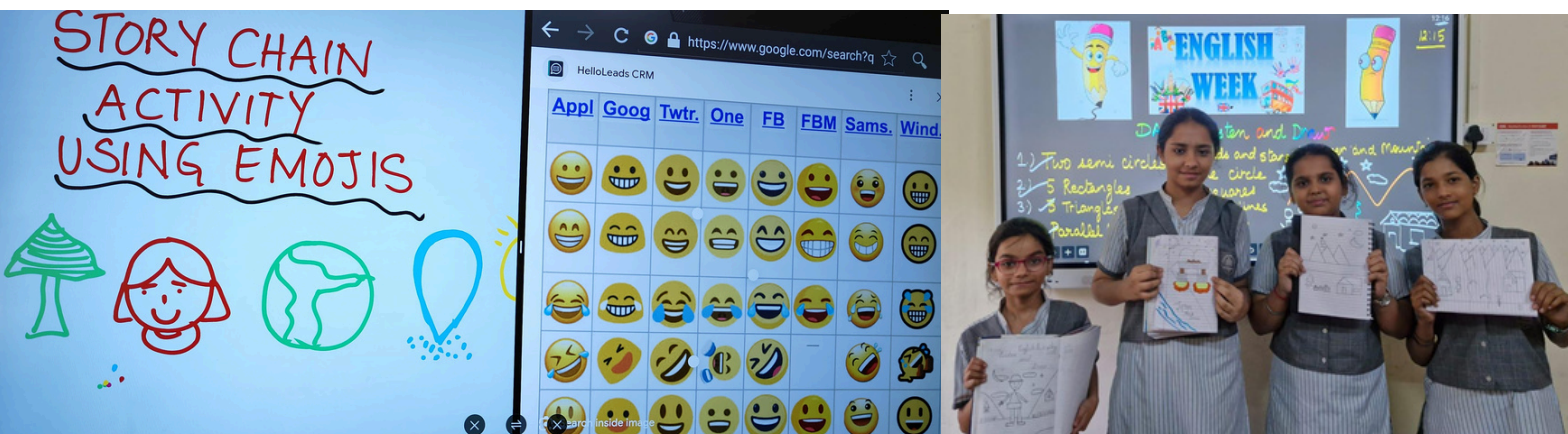


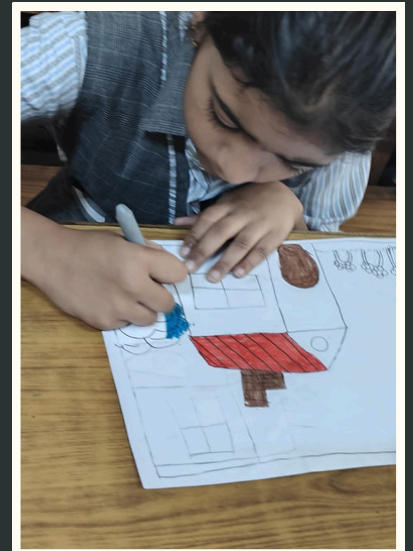
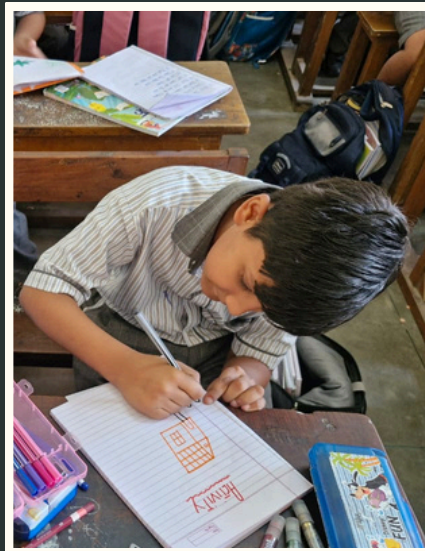
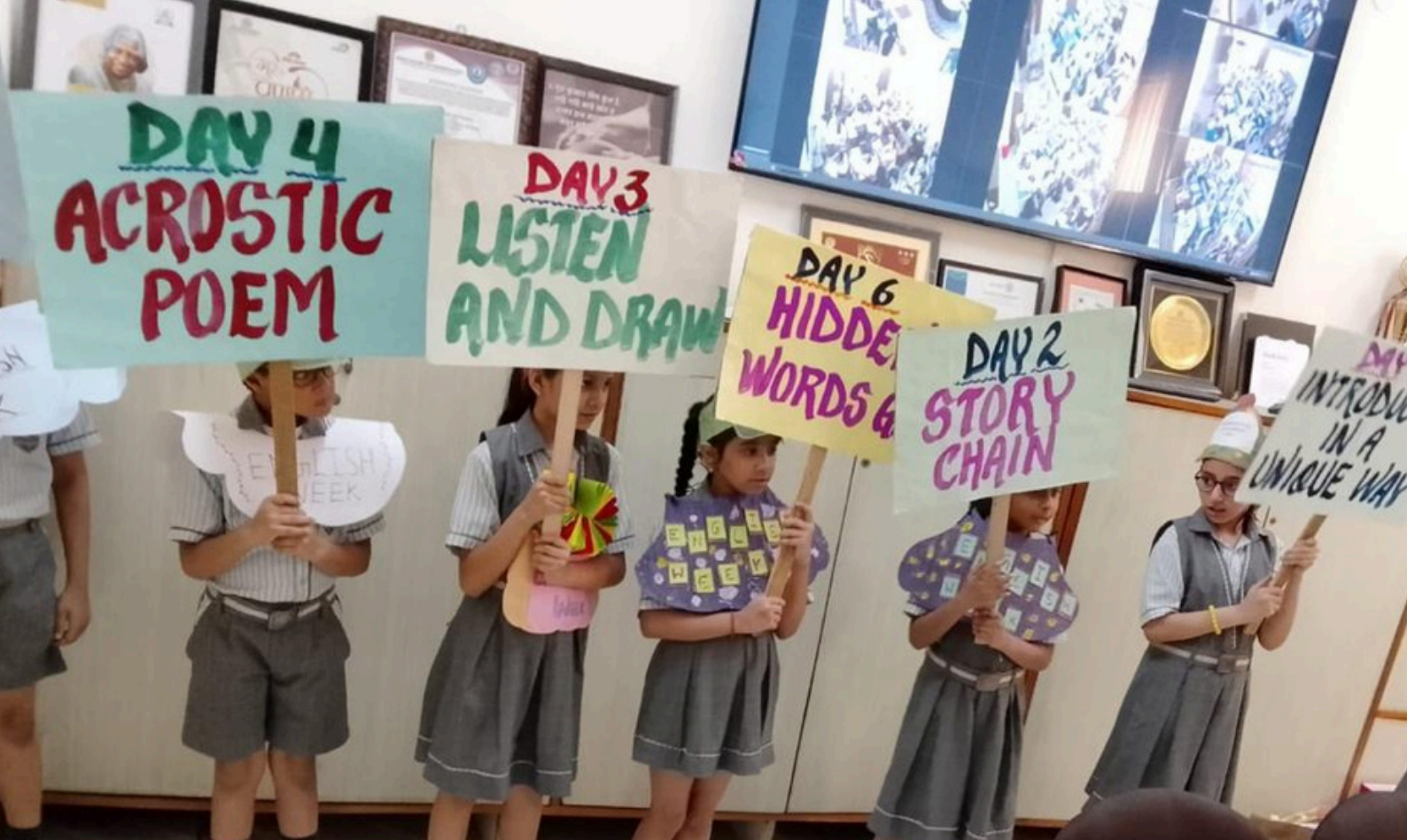
CRISIS TO CONFIDENCE: DISASTER MANAGEMENT ESSENTIALS

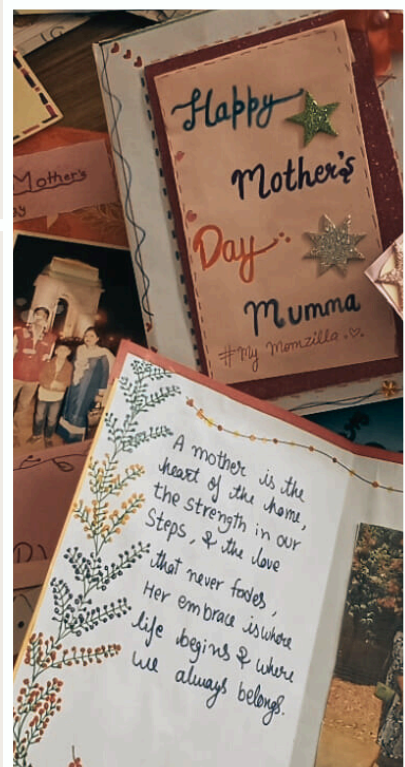
Mothers' Day
