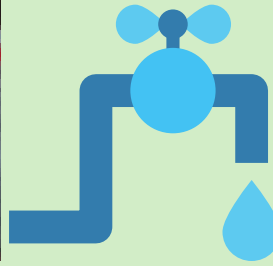
OUR STEPS TOWARDS NATURE

Presentation on “Khelo Holi Naturally” is displayed in the assembly to spread awareness about celebrating the festival in an eco-friendly manner.



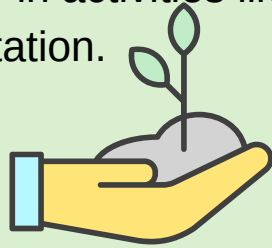
The guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board regarding ban on immersion of idols shown in the form of Power Point presentation during the assembly to generate awareness.

Our school maintains the Green House in which plants requiring regulated climatic conditions are grown.

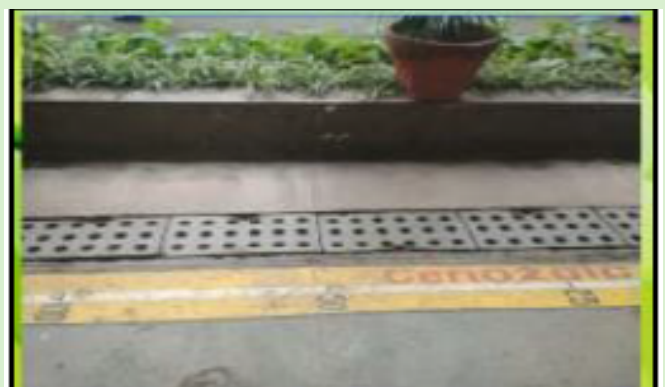
We have set up solar panel to save on electricity.



We maintain a vertical garden in our school, we also grow plants like Lemon Grass, Basil, Aloe Vera, Henna, etc.

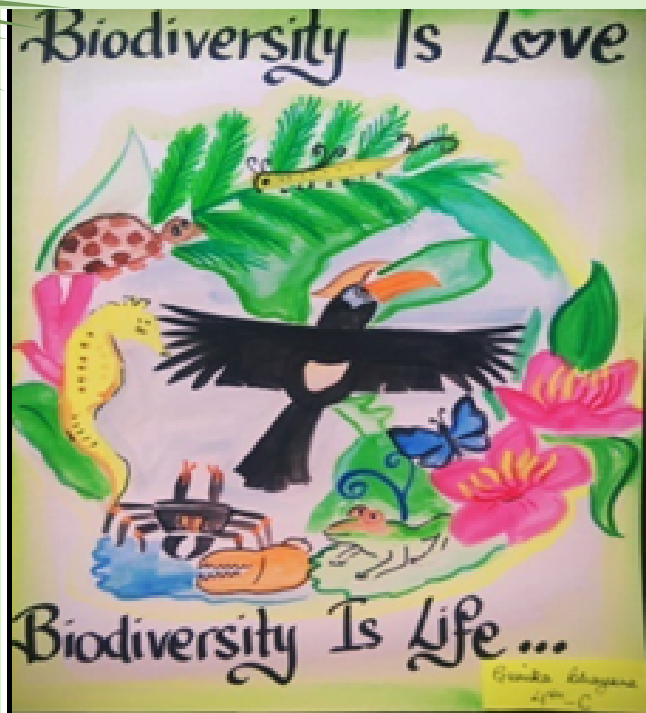


Our school has installed Rain water harvesting system as a step towards conservation of water.

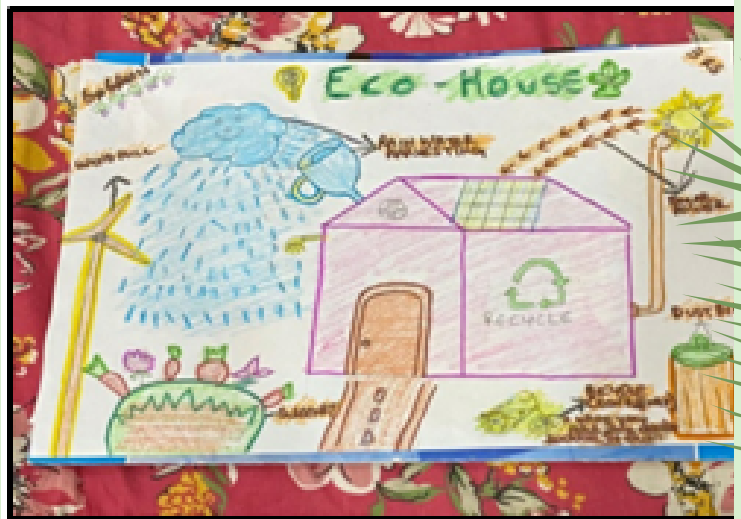
