ACTIVITY: Shadows Are Fun - A Math & Storytelling Activity

The curious young learners of **Class 2A** had an exciting time exploring the magical world of **shadows** through a fun-filled **Math and storytelling activity** titled **"Shadows Are Fun"**. Inspired by the traditional **Togalu shadow puppetry**, students discovered how shadows are formed and how their size and direction change with light.

Using **simple tools like a handkerchief and a mobile torch**, children experimented with creating shadows on the wall, turning the classroom into a mini theatre of light and imagination.
