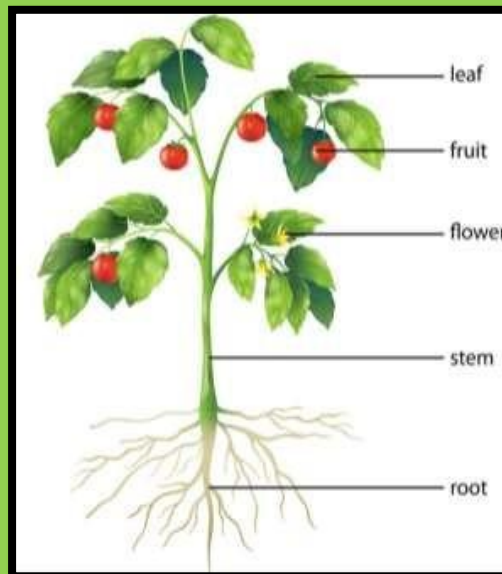

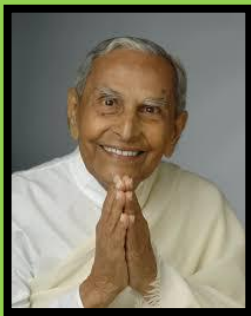

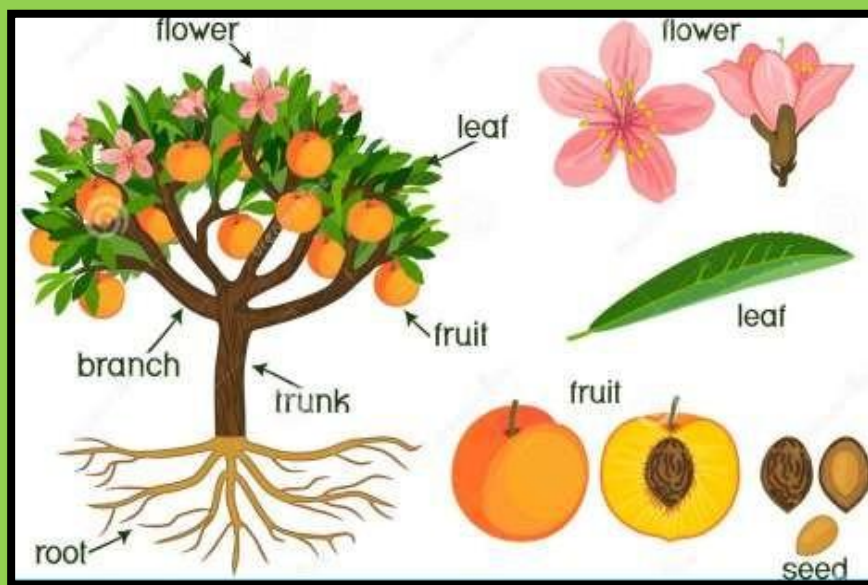
### Listening and Speaking Skills

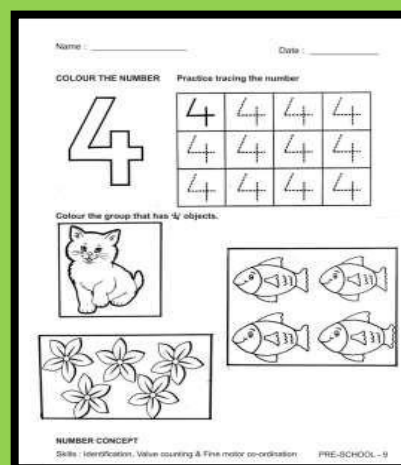
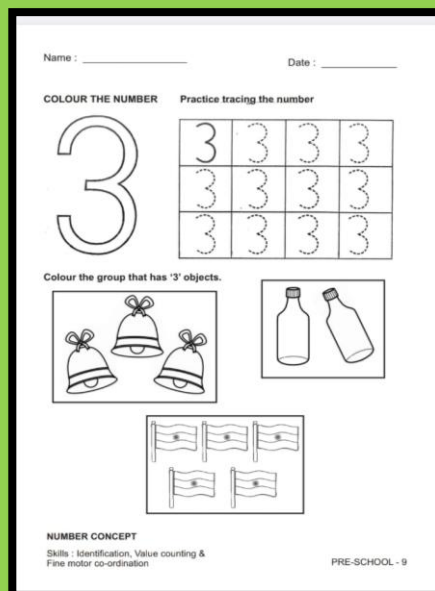




## Sports Integration

## Value Education- Caring for nature



Children will learn to water the plants, care for them, and to keep their garden/plant area clean.



### Life Skills- Awareness

Students will learn about the importance of plants, taking care of the environment, not plucking the flowers and leaves, and nurturing them with water every day.



### Attitude-Discipline

Children must be encouraged not to pluck flowers and leaves for they too, have life. This will in turn help them to respect the bounties of nature and help maintain an ecological balance.



**For Parents**

Take the child for a nature walk and show her different types of leaves, flowers, insects, and worms that are found in the garden/plant area.



Help the child identify leaves of at least three different common plants (e.g. – Tulsi, Neem, Peepal)



- Parents to reinforce pre-number concepts (e.g. - big/small, far/near, in/out, empty/full) in daily conversation.
- Please discuss the significance of festivals like Independence Day, Raksha Bandhan, and Janmashtami with your child.
- Show her pictures, videos, physically - the National Emblem, National Bird, National Animal, and National Flower.
