

# SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT & PROMOTION POLICY CLASS-XI (2025-26)

#### 1. ATTENDANCE

Every student must have a minimum of **75% attendance**, failing which he/she will not be allowed to sit in the final examination and will not be promoted to the next higher class, as per the CBSE guidelines. Please discourage the student from missing an exam unless on grounds of extreme Medical Emergency for which a medical certificate from a certified government hospital/ practitioner and supporting medical reports must be submitted on the same day till 8:30AM.

## 2. SCHEME OF ASSESSMENT

The Unit Tests will be conducted for 30 Marks each. Half Yearly and Annual exams will be conducted as per CBSE Assessment Scheme.

## 4. PASSING CRITERIA FOR CLASS XI

In order to be declared passed in Class XI Examination, the student must obtain:

- a) A minimum of 33% marks in Theory and Practical examination SEPERATELY IN all the subjects.
- **b)** Average of two unit tests will be marked.
  - o 10% of UT (Average of UT-1 and UT-2)
  - o 30% Half Yearly
  - o 60% Annual Examination
- c) Minimum Subject wise score 33% in Annual examination and 40% in Overall Score.

#### 5. MISSED / IMPROVEMENT TEST

- Maximum two Improvement tests will be conducted for promotion.
- If a student is On Duty or has missed the <u>Half yearly/Annual exam</u> due to genuine medical reasons, retest shall be conducted only once and as per the declared schedule.
- If a student is On Duty, new admission or has missed the UT exam due to genuine Medical reasons, proportionate marks may be awarded.(No retest of UT will be taken)
- If a student has missed any exam without any reasons no average shall be given ie. the student will be marked zero and there will be no retest.

#### **6. USE OF UNFAIR MEANS**

- Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students using unfair means. Their answers scripts will be cancelled and a new answer sheet will be issued and evaluated. Repeated unfair means will invite major penalization.
- Improvement examination will be conducted if a child fails in **two subjects** and if he/ she fails in **more than 2** subjects he/she will be detained.

Note:- No subject change request will be entertained after 30th May.
