ACTIVITY: Mango Treat – Number Recognition Activity

DATE: 12 August 2025

CONDUCTED BY: Class 1

The students of Class 1 enjoyed a fun-filled *Mango Treat* activity designed to strengthen their number recognition and speaking skills. Each child was given colourful mango cutouts with numbers up to 9. They counted their mangoes aloud with confidence and then framed sentences like, *"I have 5 mangoes in my basket. My friend has 3 mangoes. I have more mangoes than my friend!"*

This engaging speaking activity not only reinforced number concepts but also encouraged children to compare quantities, use mathematical vocabulary, and communicate confidently. It was a joyful blend of learning and play that made the classroom lively and interactive.
