All dogs have excellent hearing. They can hear sounds that people cannot—both high and low tones—and from far away. Dogs also have an incredible sense of smell. They can smell 40 times better than humans!

Most dogs live between 5 and 13 years, but some live much longer. One dog even lived to be 24 years old!


