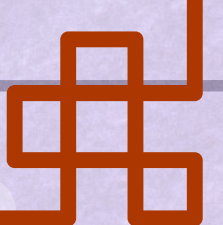
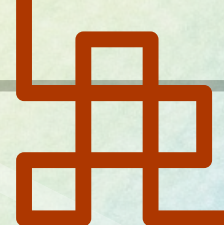
BACK TO SCHOOL

VISIT TO THE NURSERY

To nurture a love for nature, Grade 1 students visited a plant nursery as part of an educational field trip on 13 May, 2025. The interaction with the nursery gardener, provided insights into plant care, composting, and the role of plants in purifying the air. 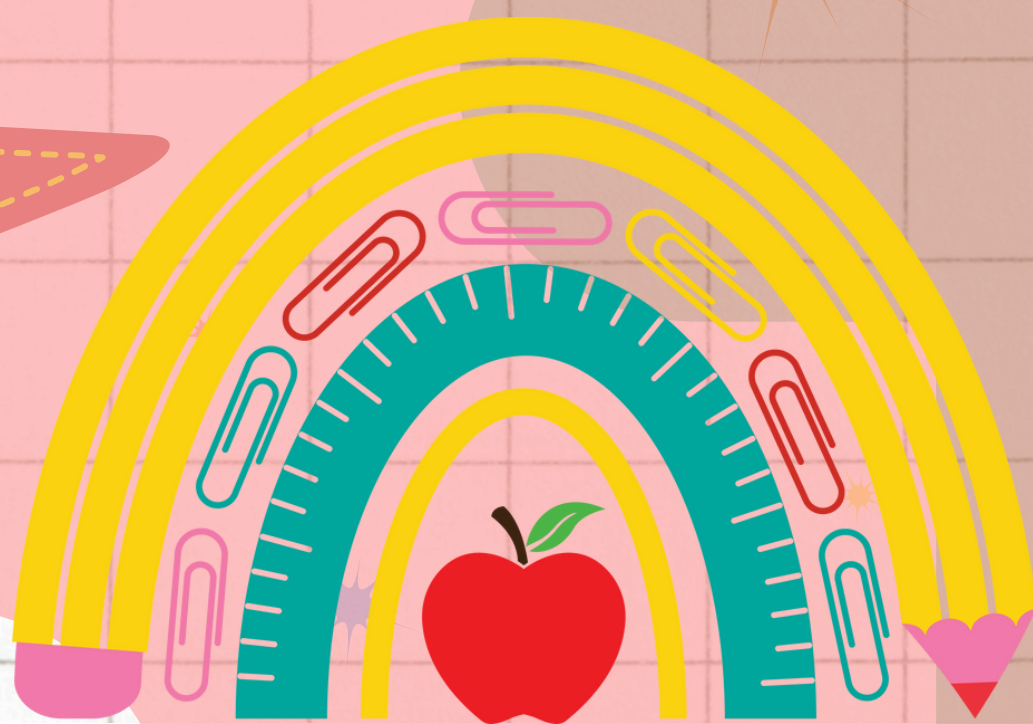
SUMMER CAMP

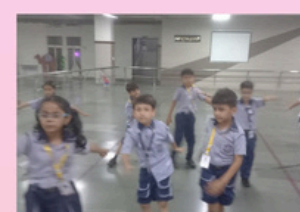
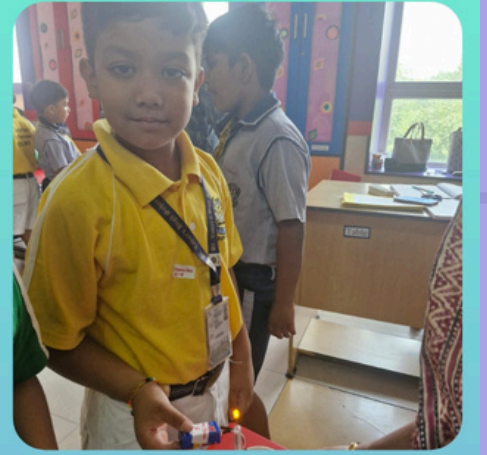
