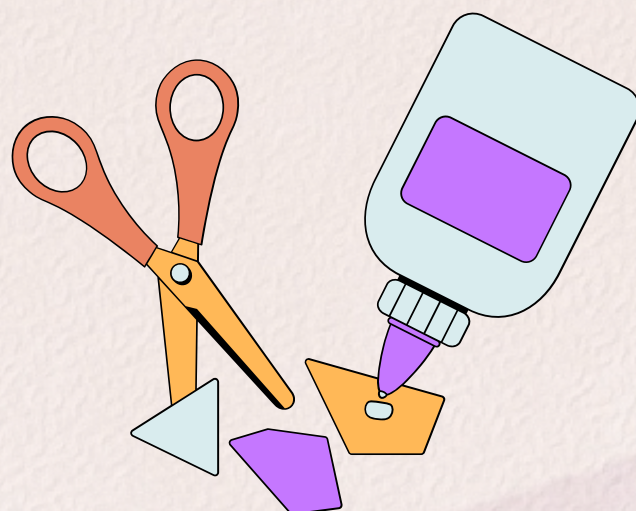
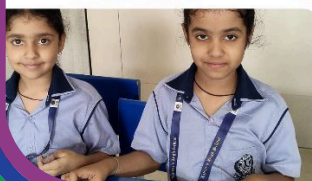
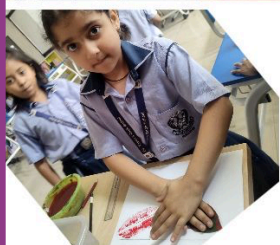




BAGLESS DAYS: ART & CRAFT

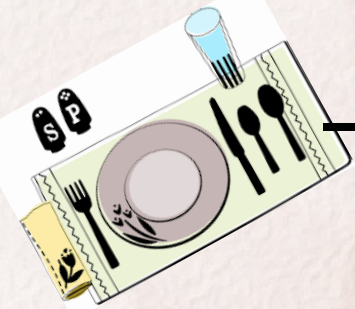


BAGLESS DAYS: CULTURAL HERITAGE

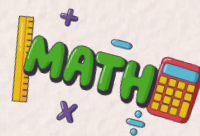

Numbers, Nerves & Noteworthy Wins!

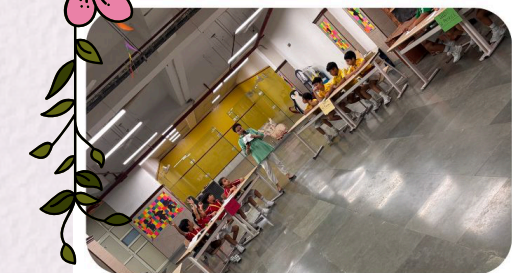



May month at St. Xavier's buzzed with excitement as Round 2 of the Inter-House Mental Math Quiz unfolded for students of Grades 3 to 5.
