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- Since **PBLs are formally assessed in Grade 4**, they are introduced in **Grade 3** to ease students in the next class and help them adapt smoothly.
 - The topics for Project-Based Learning (PBL) will be connected to the ongoing lessons or to topics already completed in class.
 - The PBL sessions will be conducted in class ensuring active participation of all students.
 - A little scaffolding from both key stakeholders—**parents and teachers**—will ensure a balanced learning experience for the students.
