

# **MYSTERY BOX**



This engaging activity not only helped students practically apply their classroom knowledge but also enhanced their creativity, reasoning, and problem-solving skills. By working with concrete materials, they developed a deeper understanding of the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes.

# **ARCHIMEDES' PRINCIPLE**

The readings were taken to compare the loss of weight of the object in water with the weight of displaced water collected in a beaker. The practical helped students understand the concept of buoyancy and up thrust in a hands-on manner. It also enhanced their scientific skills of observation, recording data, and drawing conclusions.
