



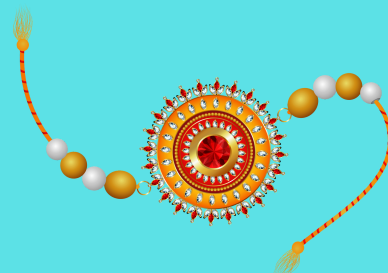
ITLa CANDYFLOSS
