- (a) **Assertion**: Carbon is the only element which can form large number of compounds. **Reason**: Carbon is tetravalent and shows the property of catenation.

3. Read the following paragraph and answer the following questions:

Soaps and detergents are widely used as cleaning agents. Chemically soaps and detergents are quite different from each other. The common feature of soaps and detergents is that when dissolved in water the molecules of soap and detergent tend to concentrate at the surface of the solution or at interface. Therefore, the surface tension of the solution is reduced, it causes foaming of the solution. A sample of water which gives lather with soap with difficulty is known as hard water, while a sample of water which gives lather with soap easily is known as soft water. Hardness of water is due to the presence of bicarbonates, sulphates and chlorides of calcium and magnesium. When hardness of water is due to the presence of bicarbonates of magnesium and calcium, it is called

temporary hardness. When hardness of water is due to the presence of sulphates and chlorides of magnesium and calcium, it is called permanent hardness.

- (ii) Micelle formation takes place when soap is added to water? State reason.
- (iii) Give a reason why soaps do not form lather in hard water?
