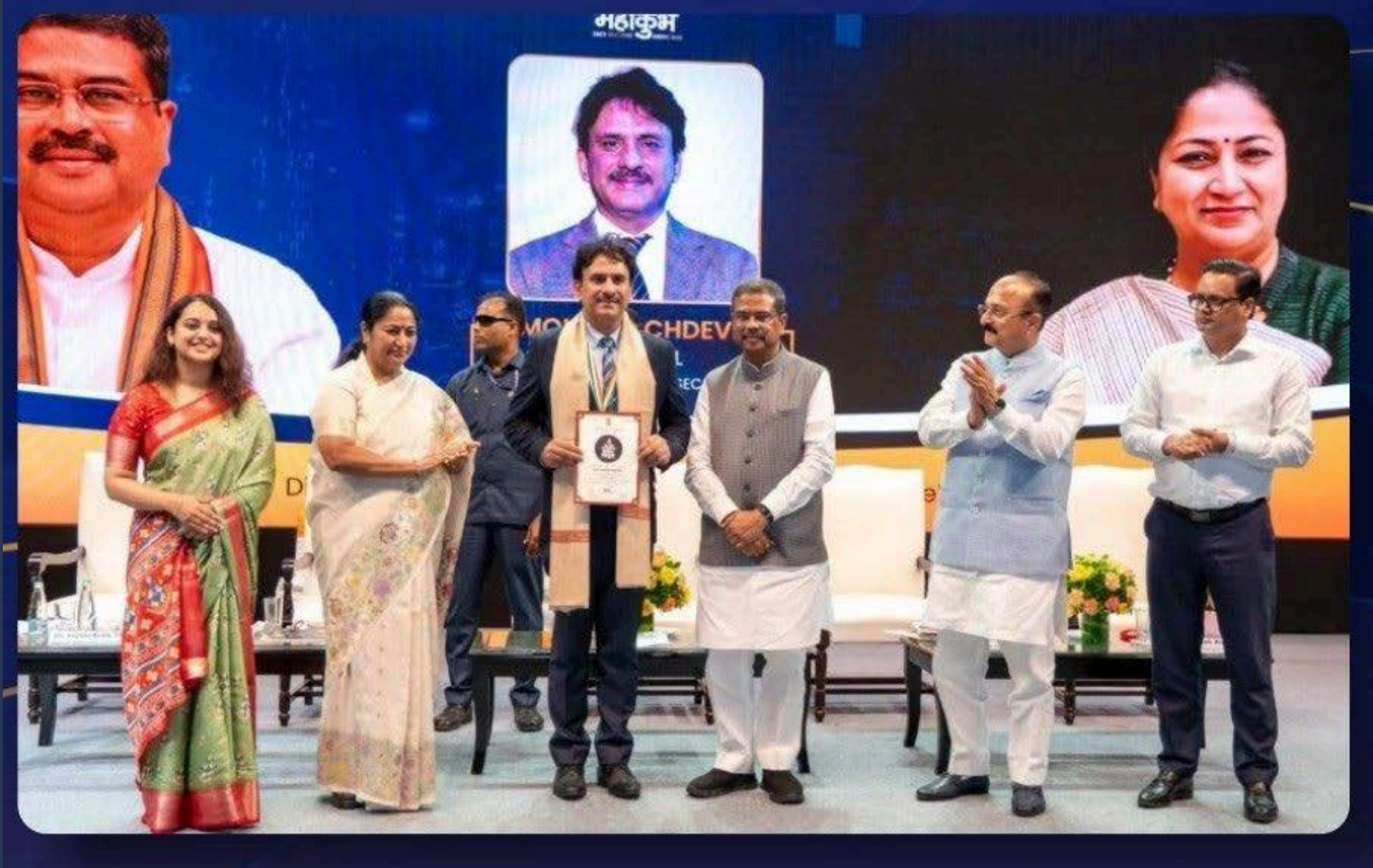

Day 3: Splish Splash Squad – Aqua Day was all about water, fun, and creativity as students celebrated Splish Splash Squad.

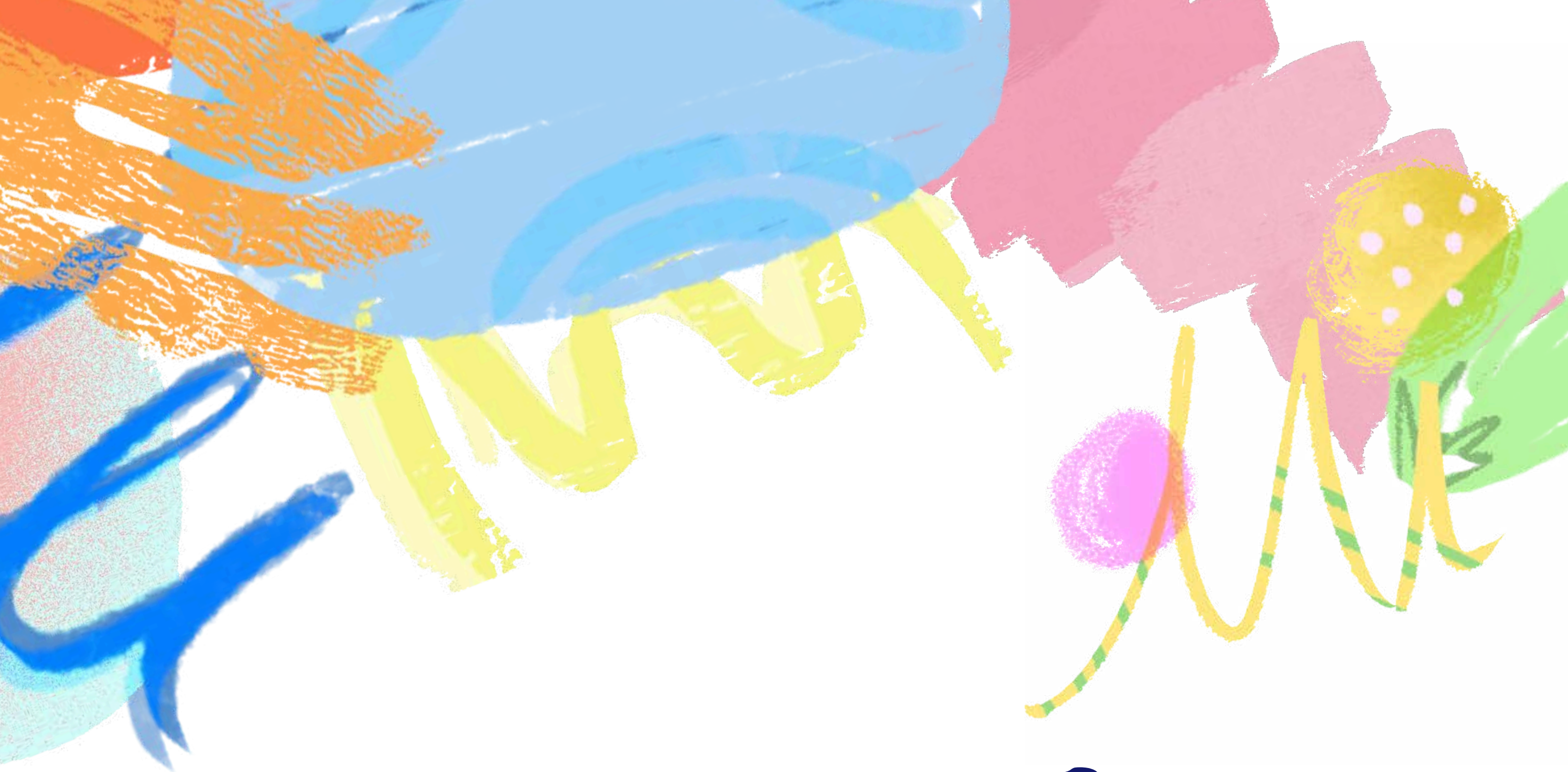

AMBEDKAR JAYANTI – 15 APRIL

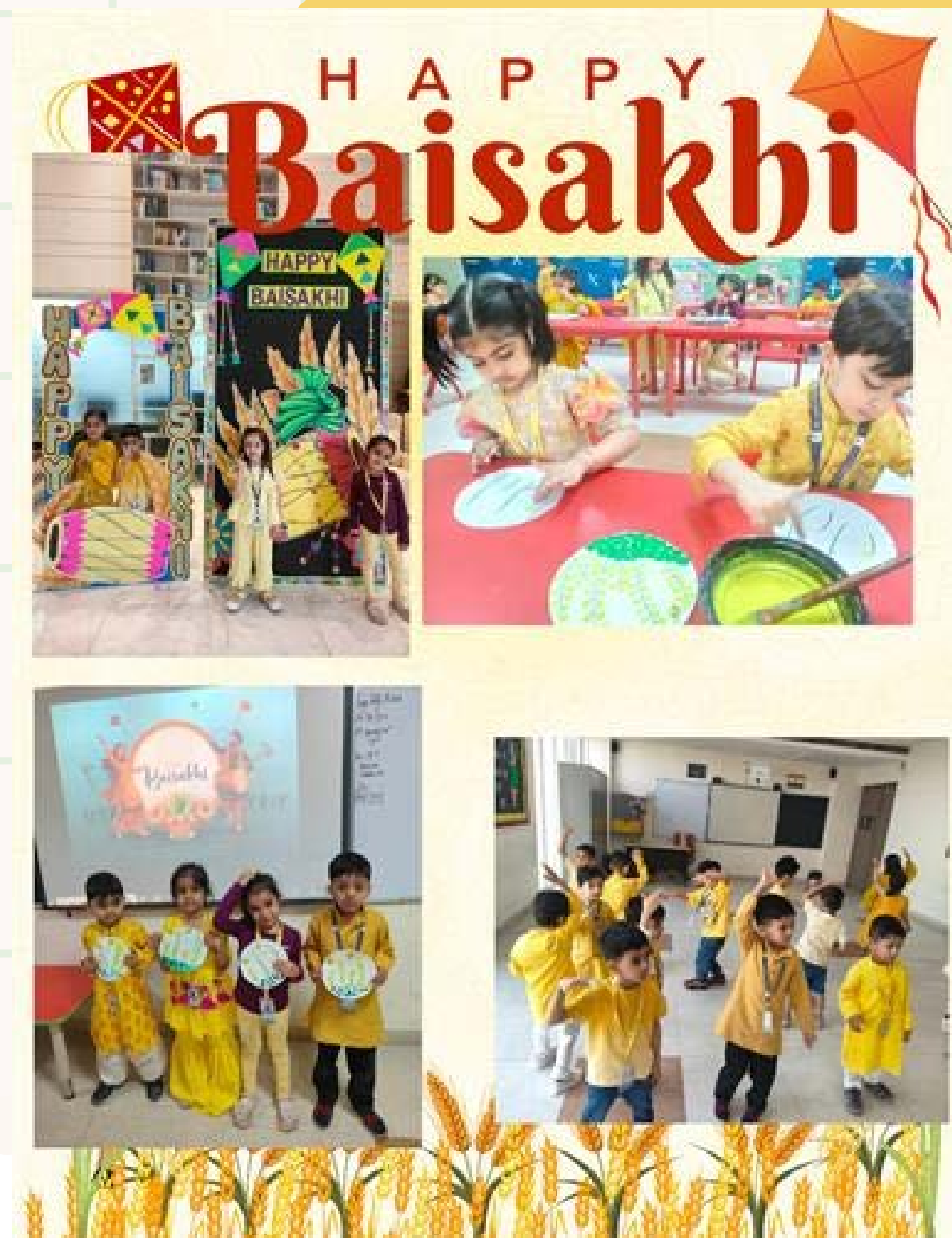
Saluting the Architect of Our Constitution

Celebrating the joy of reading, students created bookmarks, designed book covers, and explored the magical world of stories during special library visits.



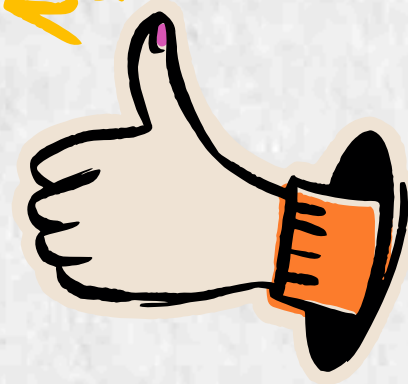
WORLD DANCE DAY – 28 APRIL

Students discovered the power of expression through movement as they learnt the significance of World Dance Day and participated enthusiastically in fun-filled dance sessions.

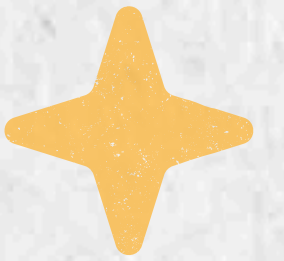

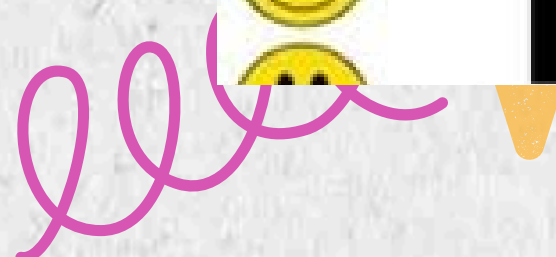
Tribute to the Backbone of Society – Labour Day Celebration | 1 May

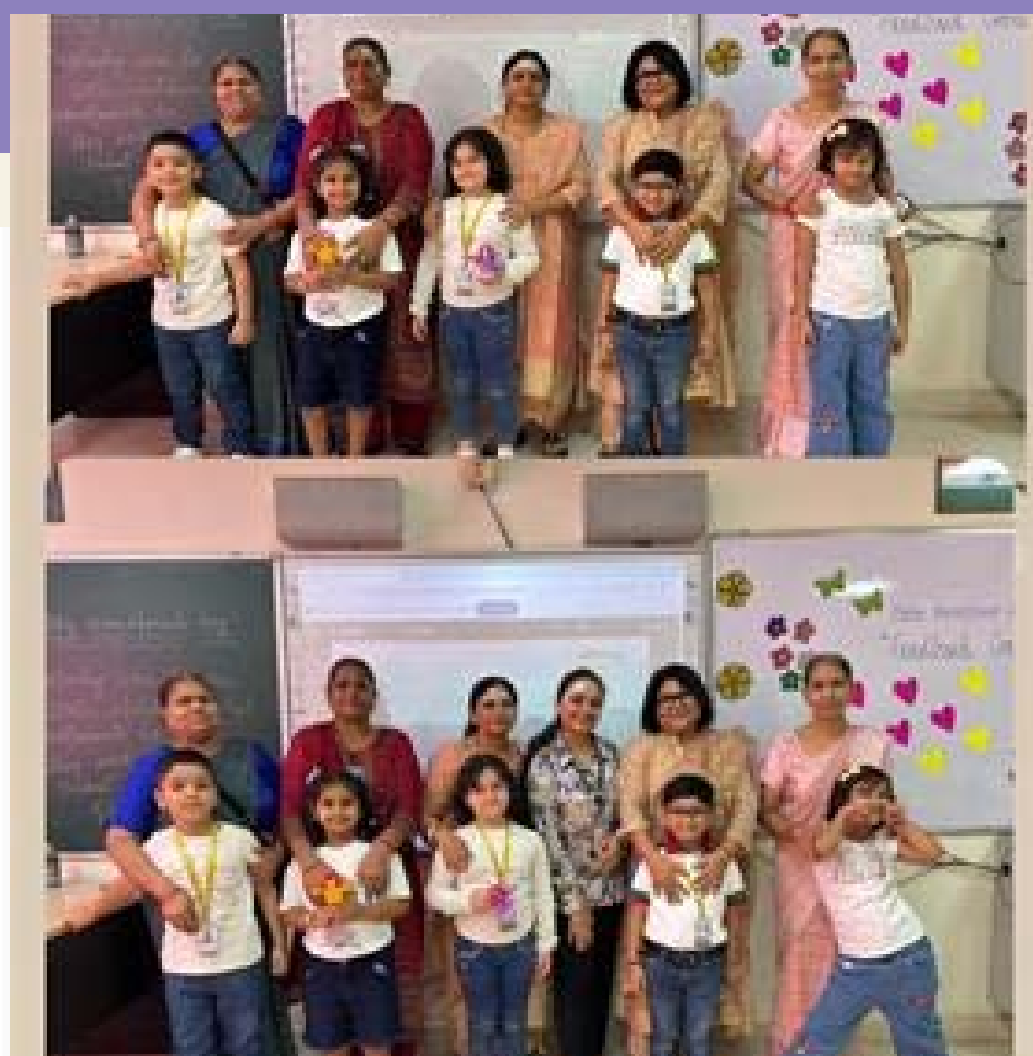

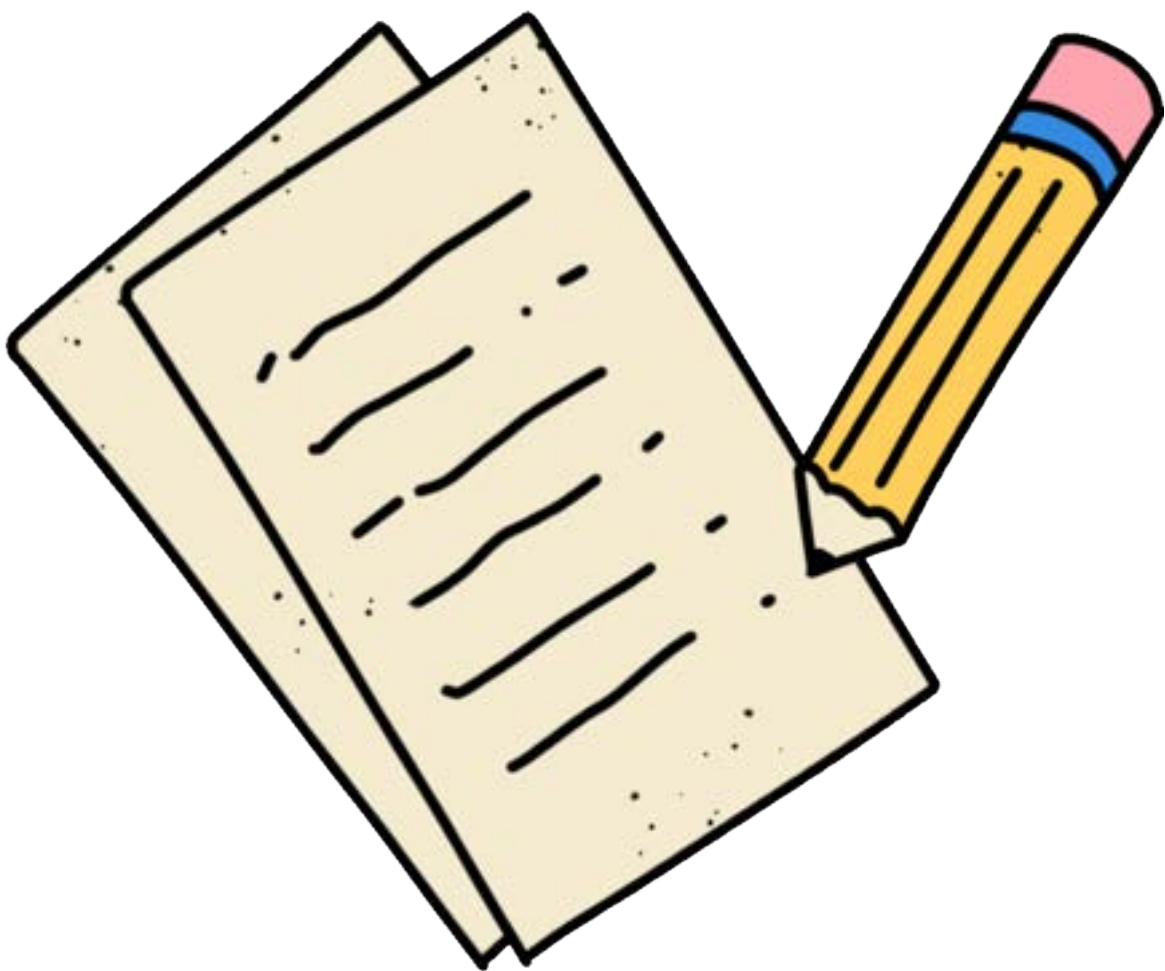

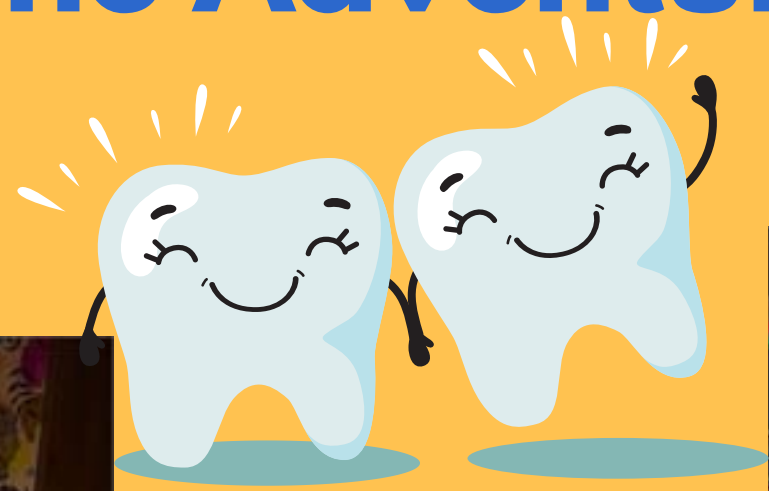
COMPOST PIT WORKSHOP

FIRST AID WORKSHOP BY MR. MANISH LAKHERA



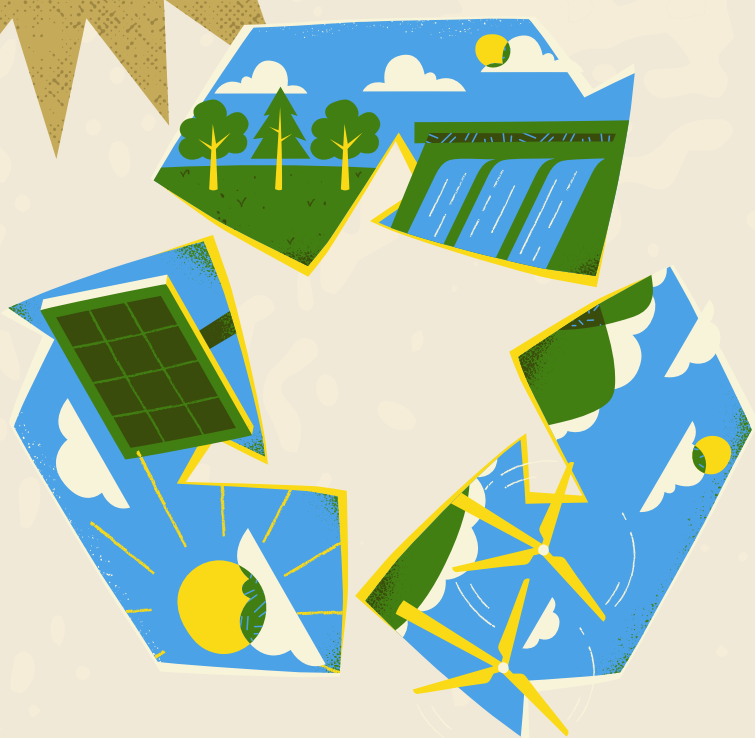

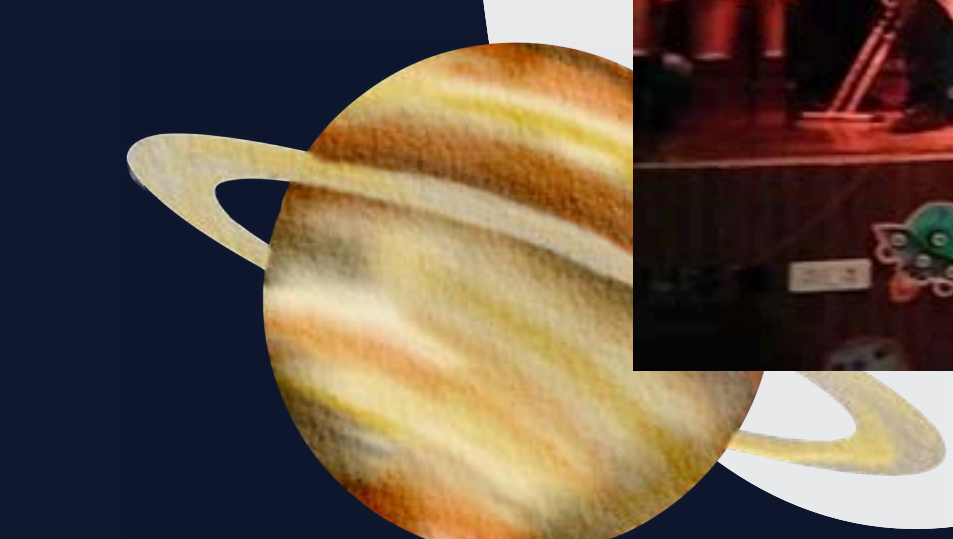

Introducing XAVBEATS



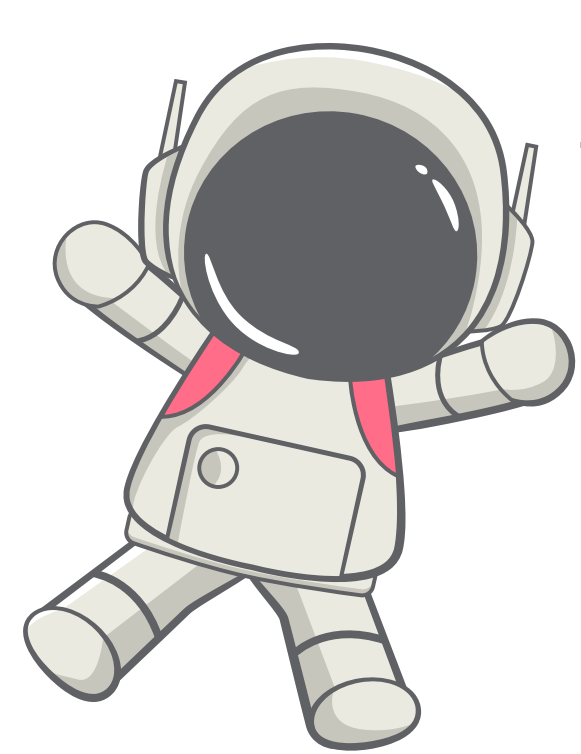

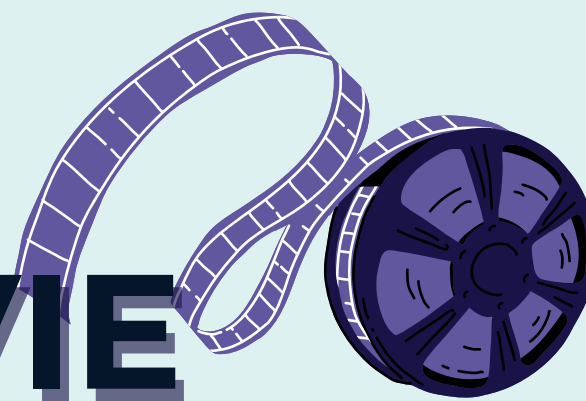
Fun-Filled Day at Trumpy Trampoline!

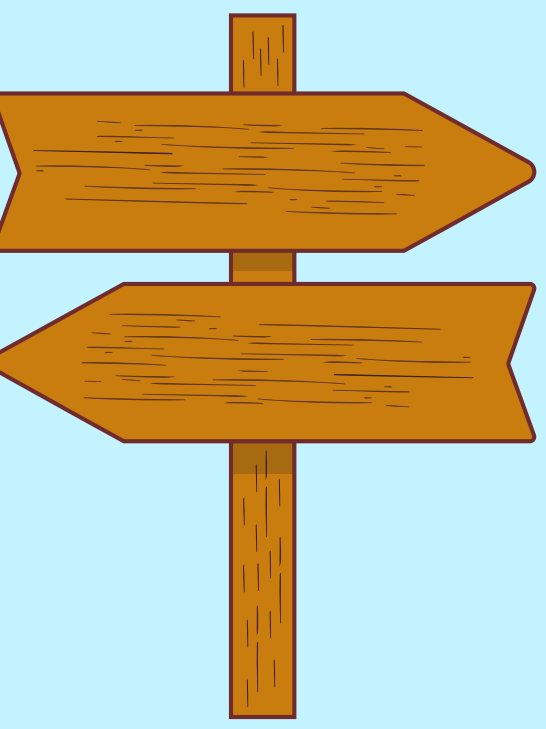
A MAGICAL MOVIE DAY OUT!

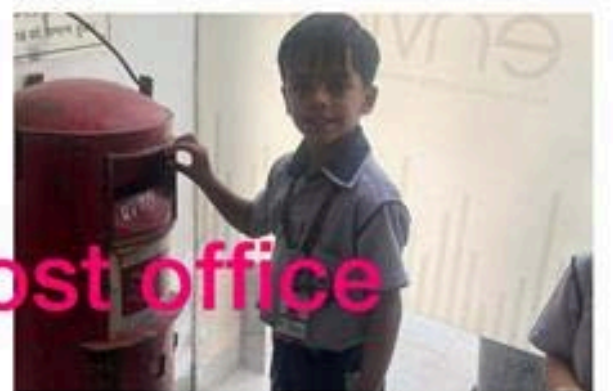

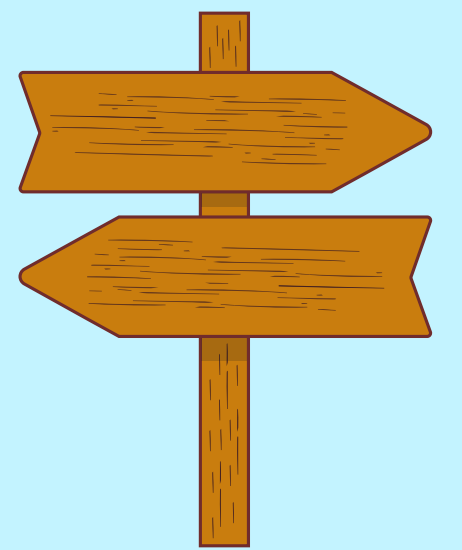
VISIT TO POST OFFICE

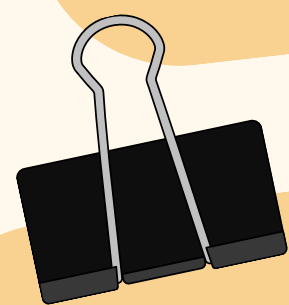

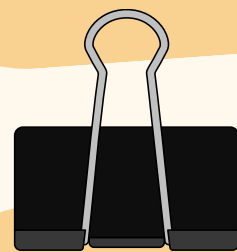

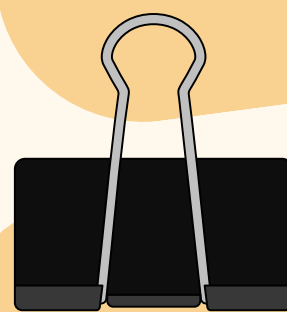
