- All India Political Parties Meet (AIPPM): Revisited the New Education Policy with a focus on the Three Language Formula.
- International Press (IP): Observed, documented, and reported on the proceedings, giving the conference its discerning voice.
- Futuristic Crisis Committee (FCC): Transported delegates into an imagined realm of intergalactic diplomacy, where imagination, strategy, and intellect determined the course of resolution.

Every committee resonated with the passion and intellect of young delegates who demonstrated diplomacy, teamwork, and depth of research.
