Interhouse Rangoli Competition (The last day Diwali Celebration)

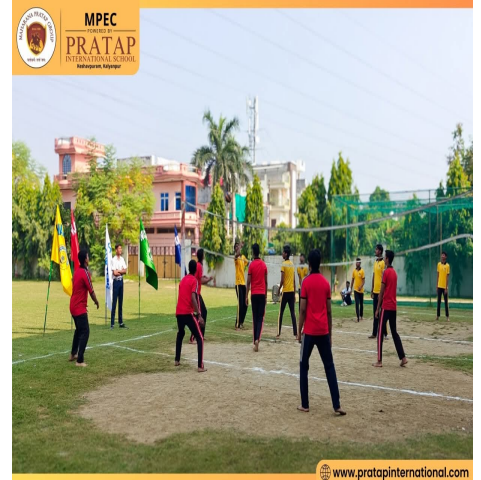
