Thank you for being an integral part of our school community. Together, we continue to create a joyful and enriching environment where every child can learn, grow, and shine.










THE ANNUAL CONCERT AT ST. XAVIER'S HIGH SCHOOL, SECTOR

PRIDE.










































































































































HAPPY DUSSEHRA


May the triumph of good over evil inspire peace, love, and prosperity in everyone's life
