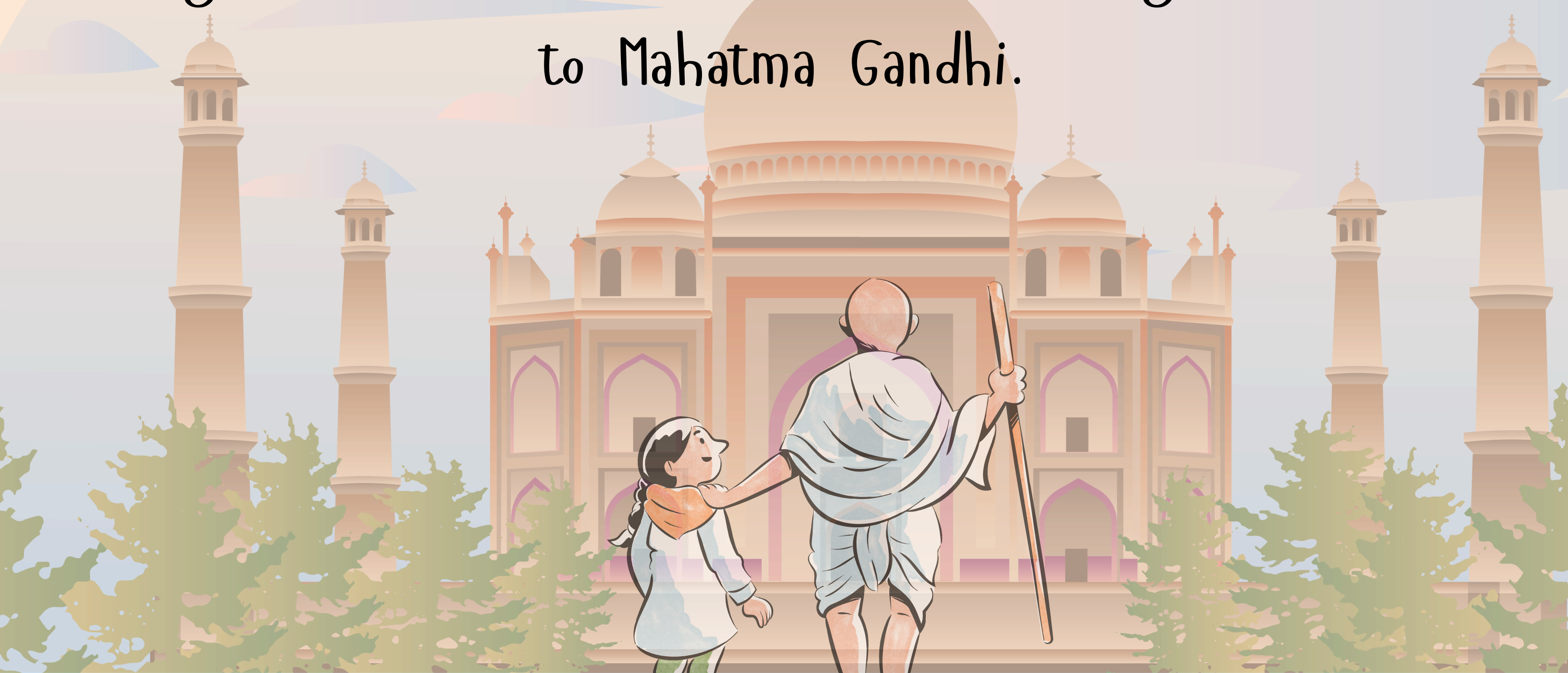

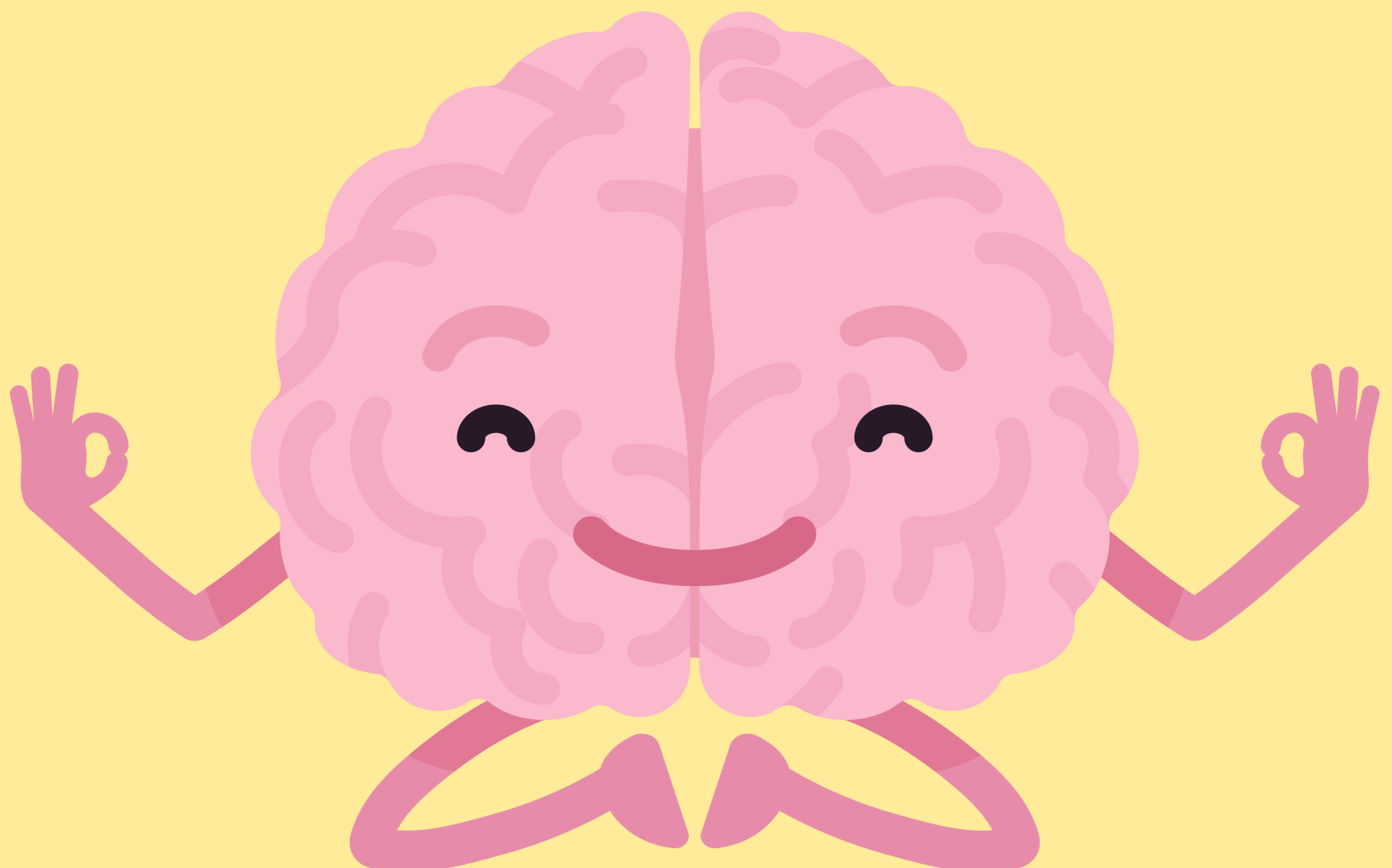




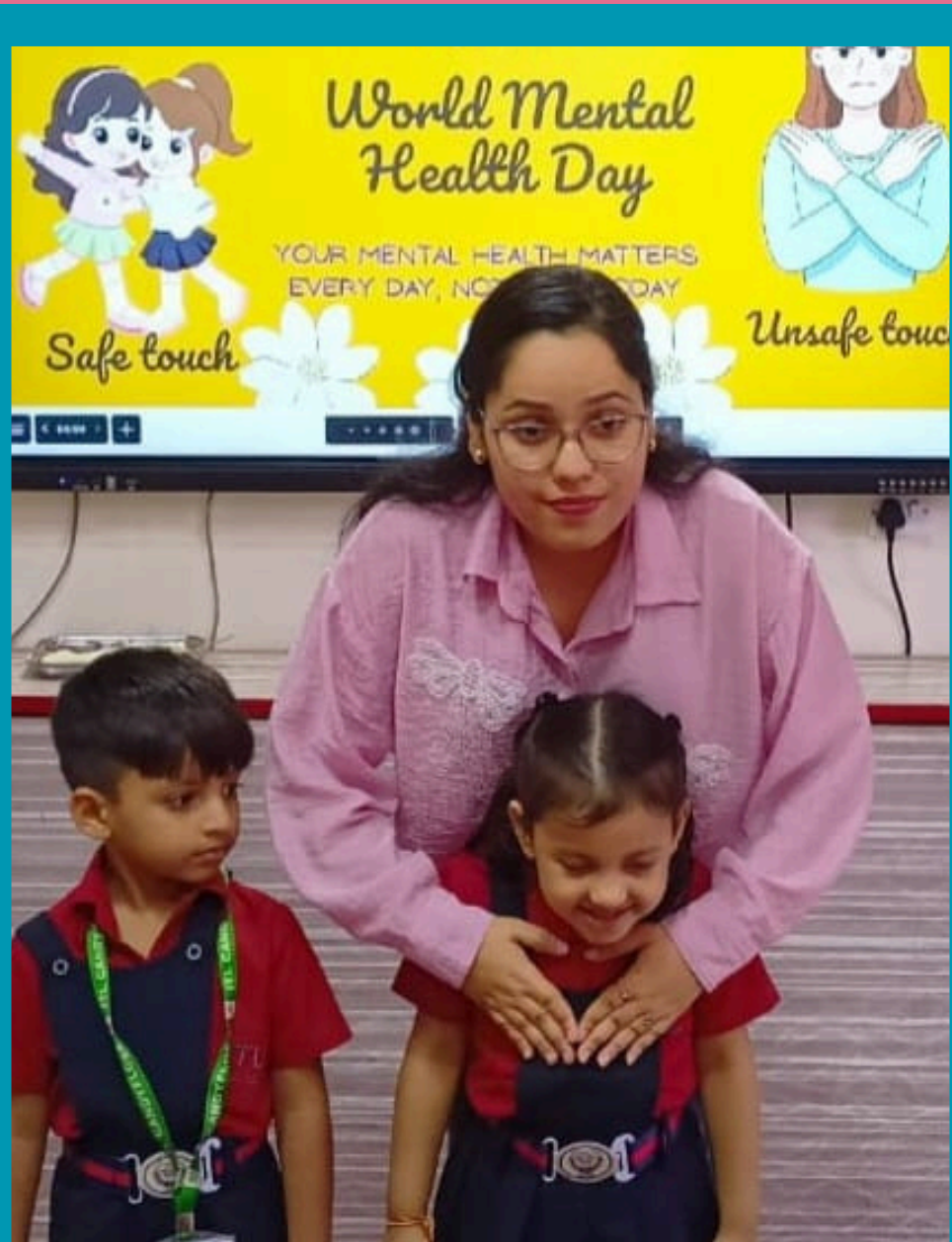
# **WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY CELEBRATION**

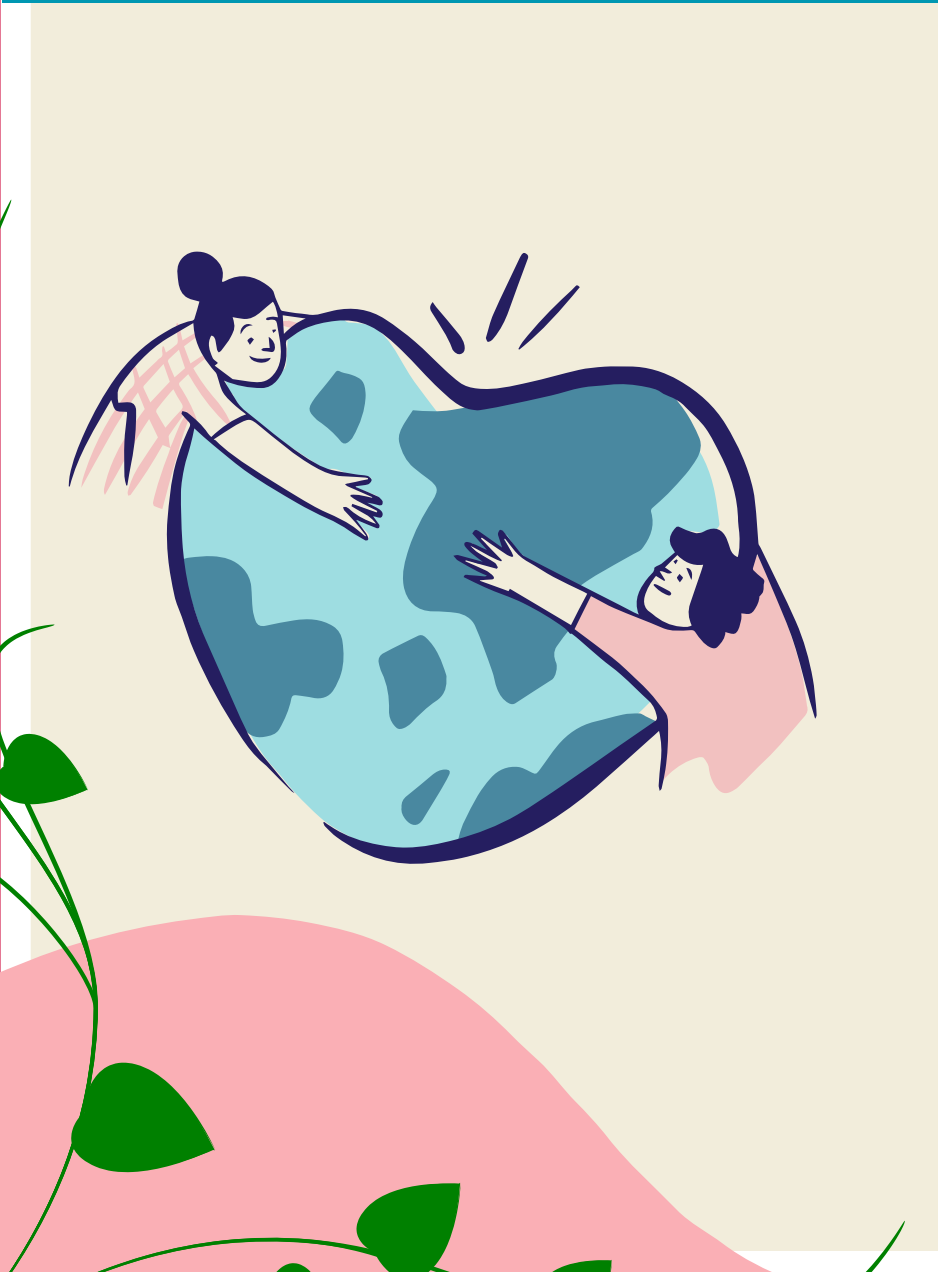
This hands-on activity beautifully reinforced trust, safety, and emotional awareness, helping children build confidence in expressing themselves.

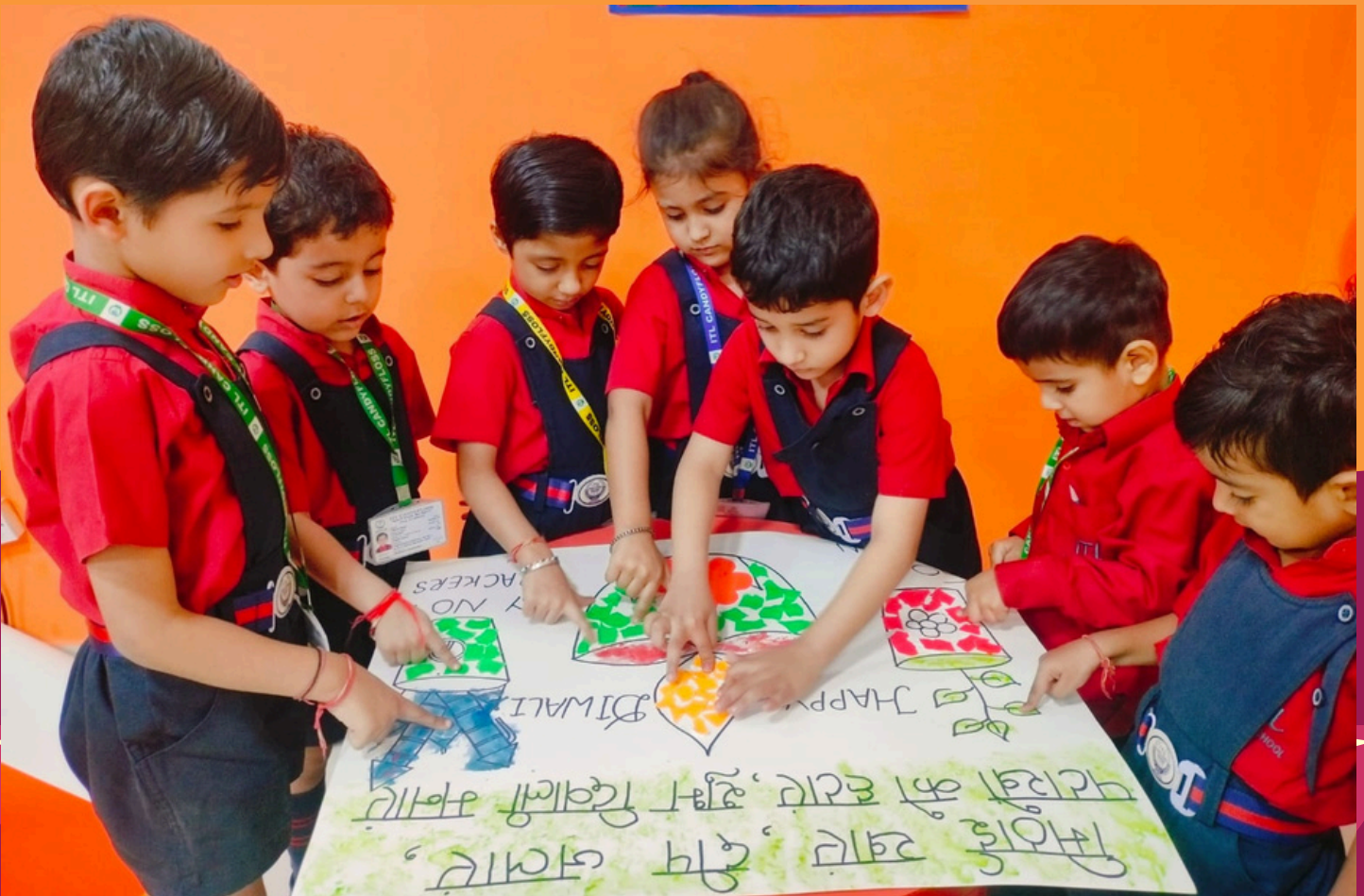

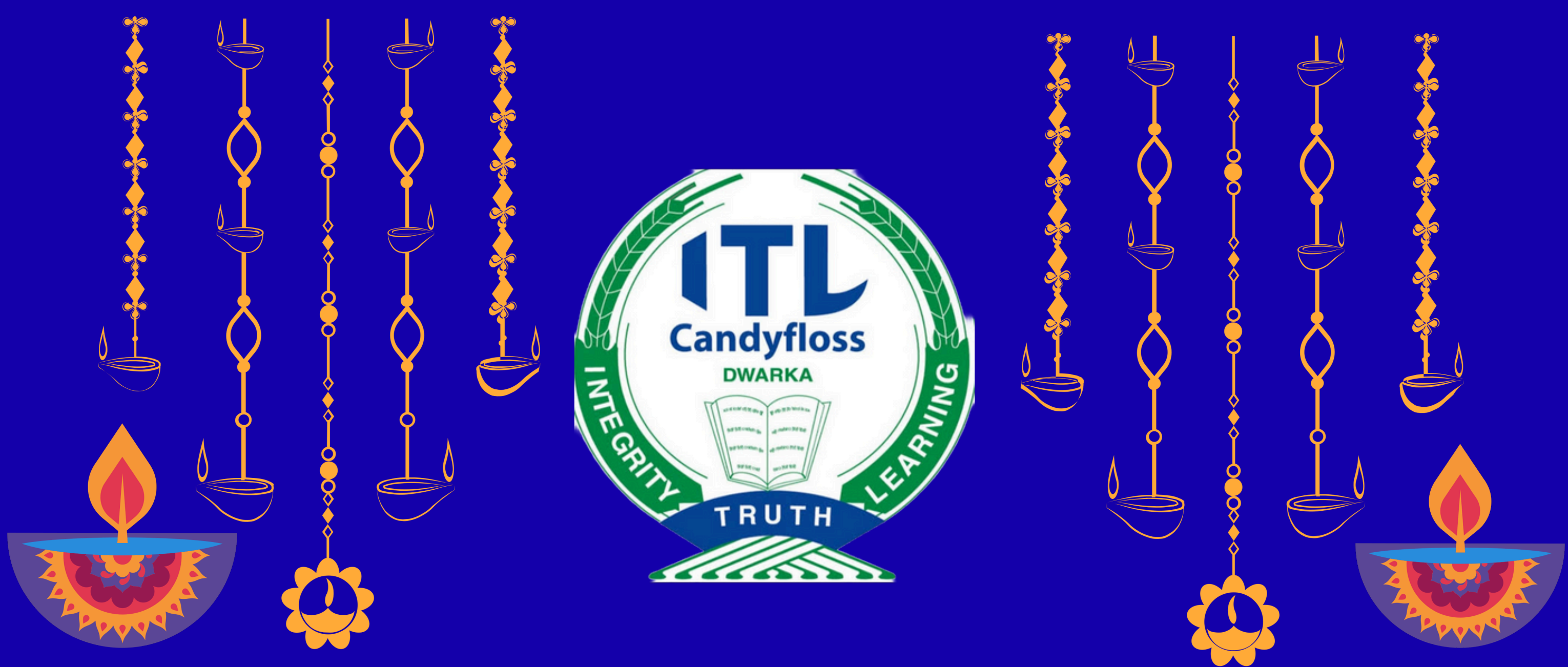
