**A Glimpse of the Event**

On 12th August, our school organized a Youth Parliament session to provide students with practical exposure to parliamentary debates and proceedings. The central theme of the discussion was “U.S. Tariffs on India”, a topic of great significance in the field of international trade and diplomacy.

The session began with the Speaker of the House welcoming the participants and explaining the rules of debate. Members representing the government highlighted how U.S. tariffs on Indian goods such as steel, aluminum, and agricultural products have created challenges for Indian exporters, impacting employment and revenue. They stressed the need for India to negotiate strategically to safeguard national interests.

On the other hand, the Opposition bench pointed out that such trade disputes also provide India with opportunities to diversify its export markets, strengthen domestic industries, and enhance “Make in India” initiatives. Several members suggested that India should take up the issue at the World Trade Organization (WTO) and push for fair trade practices.

The debate was lively, with participants presenting facts, statistics, and arguments in a structured and disciplined manner. The Speaker maintained order and ensured equal participation. At the end, a resolution was passed unanimously urging stronger diplomatic engagement with the U.S. while also promoting self-reliance in Indian industries.

The Youth Parliament not only enhanced students’ understanding of global trade relations and foreign policy but also sharpened their skills in public speaking, critical thinking, and teamwork. The event concluded with the Principal appreciating the participants for their enthusiasm and urging them to remain aware of current national and international issues.
