

Report on Inter-House Constitution Quiz

Held on 26 November 2025 (Constitution Day – commemorating 75 years of the Constitution)

To commemorate 75 years of the Indian Constitution, an Inter-House Constitution Quiz Competition was held on 26 November 2025 in the school auditorium. The event aimed to deepen students' understanding of the Constitution and promote constitutional values. The programme began with an introduction on the significance of Constitution Day, followed by welcoming the participating house teams. Each team was enthusiastic and well-prepared as the quiz commenced with the General Round, which tested knowledge of historical facts, key provisions, amendments, and constitutional bodies, setting the tone for the event. This was followed by the Audio Round, where students identified voices of constitutional leaders, freedom fighters, and prominent personalities, requiring keen listening and familiarity with national figures.

The competition continued with the Visual Round, where teams identified logos of bodies like the Election Commission and Supreme Court, as well as images representing Fundamental Rights and Duties. The Anagram Round involved decoding scrambled constitutional terms, articles, and institutions, adding energy and excitement. The final Rapid-Fire Round tested quick thinking, accuracy, and conceptual clarity under time pressure. All rounds were conducted smoothly, the quizmaster engaged the audience, and students cheered for their houses throughout. After tallying the scores, the winning house was announced, and the event concluded with a reminder about upholding the values enshrined in the Constitution.
